Dear parishioners of St. Elizabeth and St. Jules,

I would like to provide you some updates that I discussed on my recent online Parish Update. First, masks are still required when coming to Mass as recommended by the state and the diocese. However, it is permissible to loosen your mask during parts of Mass when we are not responding or singing. For the other parts, you need to be wearing your mask.

Starting on **Monday**, **June 29th**, I am going to start using St. Jules Church for Mass and sacraments once again. The Monday and Thursday 6:00 PM Masses along with the Sunday 8:30 AM Mass will now be at St. Jules. I will give directions on seating and communion at those Masses. For the time being, the Saturday 4:00pm Mass will be staying at St. Elizabeth.

With the Masses now being hosted at both church locations, I need your help in two ways. The first is that I need volunteers to be greeters for each Mass. They would help opening doors as worshipers arrive, help with seating if needed, and hand out bulletins at the end of Mass. The second way is that I need volunteers to help clean the Church immediately after Mass. We have been very fortunate and grateful to the Carmelite Sisters for cleaning after the Masses. In order to help keep everyone safe, I need groups to help with this important new task. The more volunteers I get, the better. It only takes about 10 min after Mass to wipe the surfaces. If you are interested in volunteering for these roles, please call the Church office.

Finally, I am comfortable with allowing ministers to once again help with Mass especially altar servers and Eucharistic ministers. Wendy Ourso, my administrative assistant, will be sending out messages to those are who currently signed up for this ministries. If you would like to help in these ministries for the first time, please contact the church office. More to come!
