Invitation to pray: Lectio Divina

Reading the Scriptures is a fundamental aspect of being in communion with the Lord. It is the Word of God given to us. We should not be neglectful of the Scriptures, but consistently read and pray with them so as to learn to hear the voice of the Lord who desires to be in an intimate relationship with us. The Church offers to us an awesome way to read Scripture: Lectio Divina. It consists of four steps:

- 1) **Reading**—Read for the context. What is happening? Who is present? Read it again and again slowly so as to allow the Word to penetrate your hearts.
- 2) **Meditation**—As you're reading, if a word, phrase, sentence jumps out to you, stop. Sit with what stuck out to you and ponder, "Why is this sticking out to me?" Trust that it is the Holy attempting to move within you in that moment.
- 3) **Prayer** Speak to God. Prayer is ultimately friendship with God. Speak to the Lord. "Lord, this scripture makes me feel loved. I feel conviction." Journal your prayer and conversation with the Lord. Ask the Lord to reveal Himself more to you. Spend time with Him.
- 4) **Contemplation** This is a pure gift from God that we cannot force. If He so desires it, He will draw you into a deeper level of contemplation and intimacy with Him. If not, sit with Him and just be in His presence, resting in His love for you in the Word.

Check out the video on Fr. Matthew's YouTube channel explaining more. Start with the Sunday Gospel! You can find the readings in the Breaking Bread book or USCCB.org. It is beautiful to begin to hear his voice in the Scriptures!


