Dear Friends,

Monday September 14, we celebrate the feast of the Exaltation of the Cross. The feast has its origin in early fourth century when Saint Helena, mother of the Roman Emperor Constantine, went to Jerusalem and during the excavation, workers found three crosses. Legend has it that the one on which Jesus died was identified when its touched healed a dying woman.

Tuesday September 15, we celebrate the feast of Our Lady of Sorrows. Devotion to the Seven Sorrows of Our Lady has its roots in Sacred Scripture and in Christian piety, which always associates the Blessed Mother with her suffering Son. Today's feast was introduced by the Servites to intensify devotion to Our Lady's Sorrows. In 1817 Pius VII — suffering grievously in exile but finally liberated by Mary's intercession — extended the feast to the universal Church. These two feasts are important celebrations in the lives of Christians. These feasts explain that crosses and pains are part of our lives and saints and sinners alike go through them, and it was through the painful cross the Lord redeemed us.
