

MAY CROWNING AT HOME 2020

PREPARATION FOR THE CROWNING

- 1. Choose a date and time during the month of May that works for your family. Some suggestions are:
 - a. Any Saturday in May! Saturday's are normally dedicated to Mary in the Liturgy
 - b. May 10-Mother's Day (Mary is our heavenly mother!)
 - c. May 13-The Feast of Our Lady of Fatima
 - d. May 24-The Feast of Mary, Help of Christians
 - e. May 31-The Feast of the Visitation of the Angel Gabriel to Mary
- 2. Get a statue of Mary
 - a. If you don't have a statue, you could borrow one, or order one from a website like https://www.catholiccompany.com/
- 3. Decide on a location for the statue and add some decor like fresh flowers, a white cloth, a scripture quote, a page to write prayer intentions, etc.
- 4. Make a crown
 - a. You could use <u>these instructions</u>, finding substitutions if you don't have some of the materials (for example, use safety pins instead of a hot glue gun, or real flowers from the back yard if you don't have fake ones!)
- 5. Choose two or more Marian songs to sing for the service, such as those listed in the "Order of Service" below. You may want to practice the songs ahead of time!
- 6. Assign roles for the service to members of your family. Some suggested roles:
 - a. Someone to lead the prayer service
 - b. Someone to lead the family in the songs
 - c. Someone to read the scripture passage
 - d. Someone to place the crown on Mary's head
- 7. Finally, remind your family why we crown Mary in the month of May
 - a. She is our mother, yes, but she is also the Queen of Heaven and Earth! We give her an earthly crown in the spring to mirror the heavenly crown Jesus placed on her head.
 - b. We do this in May because in spring God's creation shows us the warmth, beauty and freshness of life that we can find when we rest in Mother Mary's arms.

ORDER OF SERVICE

Leader: We begin "In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit"

All: Amen

Leader: Let us join in singing "Hail Mary Full of Grace.."

READING OF THE MAGNIFICAT

Reader: A reading from the holy gospel according to Luke

The angel Gabriel was sent from God to a town of Galilee called Nazareth, to a virgin betrothed to a man named Joseph, of the house of David, and the virgin's name was Mary.

And coming to her, he said, "Hail, full of grace! The Lord is with you."

But she was greatly troubled at what was said and pondered what sort of greeting this might be.

Then the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God.

Behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall name him Jesus.

He will be great and will be called Son of the Most High,

and the Lord God will give him the throne of David his father, and he will rule over the house of Jacob forever, and of his Kingdom there will be no end." But Mary said to the angel, "How can this be, since I have no relations with a man?" And the angel said to her in reply, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. Therefore the child to be born will be called holy, the Son of God. And behold, Elizabeth, your relative, has also conceived a son in her old age, and this is the sixth month for her who was called barren; for nothing will be impossible for God." Mary said, "Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord. May it be done to me according to your word." Then the angel departed from her.
