From the Pastor's Desk

My dear friends in Christ,

Please check the bulletin for daily Mass changes during the months of June and July.

Thanks to all who helped with the Eucharistic Procession at St. Albert last Sunday. A special thanks to the Knights of Columbus who purchased the canopy. Thanks!

As the time for our merger draws closer, we have moved a few more steps forward in our consolidation efforts.

Last week, we sent out our first pastorate wide Flocknote and used our new name "Epiphany of the Lord" for the first time. As we continue the merger process, you'll see changes like this in the upcoming months.

Why are we making these changes? In this case, a pastorate Flocknote eliminates the need for 3 people to generate similar information weekly. A pastorate Flocknote shares and invites all parishioners to ministries and events that are happening within our pastorate.

What else will be changing?

WEBSITE: At the end of June/beginning of July our Pastorate will have one website. You'll be able to find all the information you need in one convenient location vs. having to go to each existing website!

LIVESTREAM: We'll move to livestreaming one Mass per weekend switching between churches. This will reduce the amount of staff and volunteer time needed to provide this ministry while still sharing with our homebound parishioners the opportunity to celebrate Mass in our pastorate with us.

CENTRAL OFFICE: As part of the merger process, one location needs to be designated as the Central Office for the Pastorate. The current Sacred Hearts Office will become that location and will be renamed as Epiphany of the Lord Parish Office. Why this office and not one of the others? It has the largest amount of office space available. It is fairly centrally located within the pastorate. With the location of Sacred Hearts school adjacent to the office building, 9 months of the year, there is a large amount of activity happening throughout the week. What does this mean for the other offices in our pastorate? You will still be able to go to the office you are familiar with, but the hours will be modified.
