KEY CONCEPT

Jesus' words and actions teach us how to love and serve God. When you serve others, you are serving God.

Why We Go to Mass

- The Mass is the Divine Liturgy and our most important form of worship.
- During the Mass, we listen to the Word of God through Scriptures and receive the body, blood, soul and divinity of Jesus.
- The priest, who acts *in persona Christi* (in the person of Christ), represents the eternal and perfect sacrifice of Jesus on the cross.
- Since Jesus commanded us to break bread in remembrance of his (Luke 22:19), we are simply doing what he told us to do!

Let us Pray

- Say Our Father
- Read the "At your Service" poem.

At Your Service

"Help me get my shoes on,"
Felipe whined quite loud.
"I'll help you, little brother,"

Ask: Why did Rosa help Felipe? What do you do when someone asks you for help?

TIP

Jesus the Servant

- Read paragraph
- Read God's Word about washing the disciple's feet.
- Read Serve Like Jesus paragraph
- Activity Do the cut apart activity to show how Jesus washed the disciples' feet. They can cut it out, color, and paste it onto a sheet of construction paper.

Disciples of Jesus

- Read paragraphs and discuss how you can be a follower of Jesus.
- Activity Watch me Serve sheet (Use quick tip section on pg. 186 to give children ideas on how they can serve others. This includes listing concrete actions, such as making their beds at home or helping a teacher pass out papers at school. They can also serve by listening well at school or in Church and being cooperative at home.)

Serve God and Others

- Read paragraphs
- Do Connect Your Faith section on pg. 187

Read book - "Jesus, I Feel Close to You" or other book you feel is appropriate

STEP 4 - LIVE

TIP

Our Catholic Life

- Read paragraphs
 - Explain that doing what Jesus did is not just about washing feet, it means that we follow Jesus by serving others.
 - Have the children place a check mark next to the things they would like to do to serve others. Remind the children that when they do these things, they are following Jesus and being good disciples.
 - Activity Ways to Love Others Sheet. Talk about what each one means to help the children pick a way they can show they love others.






