God Speaks to Us (pg. 236)

- Ask: Why is the Liturgy of the Word Important?
- Read paragraphs
- Read Scripture passage. Ask: How do you express your gratitude to God during the liturgy?

Read paragraph

Proclaimed and Preached

- Read paragraph
- Have the children review The Liturgy of the Word section. Then make a game and quiz them to see who can remember the parts of the liturgy of the word.
- Can look on pg. 313 to see where the Liturgy of the Word falls within the order of the Mass.
