~ **From the Pastor** ~

“My heart's desire and prayer to God for them is that they may be saved.” Romans 10:1



Happy Sixth Sunday of Easter! This great season is unfolding quickly. Next Sunday, we will celebrate Our Lord's Ascension into Heaven and then the great feast of Pentecost...all of it during this month of May, dedicated to Our Lady.

May is a month beloved and welcomed for many reasons. In our part of the world, Spring comes with a wonderful array of colorful flowers and normally, the weather allows for more time outdoors, like walks and little trips. For the Sacred Liturgy, May is always part of the Easter Season, the time of the “Alleluia”, of the revelation of

Christ's mystery in the light of the Resurrection and of our Paschal faith; and it is the time of awaiting the Holy Spirit who descended upon the Church powerfully at Pentecost, the 50th day of Easter. The Church's tradition of dedicating the month of May to the Blessed Virgin Mary harmonizes very well with both these contexts, the natural and the liturgical. Indeed, she is the most beautiful flower to have unfolded since the Creation, the “rose” that appeared in the fullness of time when God, by sending His Only Begotten Son, gave the world a new springtime. At the same time, she humbly and discreetly takes the leading role in the first steps taken by the Christian community: Mary is its spiritual heart since her very presence among the disciples is a living memory of the Lord Jesus and a pledge of the gift of His Holy Spirit. Because Our Lord received His human nature from Our Lady (and had no earthly father), her resemblance to Our Lord was striking...and so even her physical presence was a powerful reminder to the first Christian Community of Our Lord and His holy presence as He promised. May Our Lady help us to prepare well for the great feasts of the Ascension and Pentecost that are approaching, and during these days of May, may our understanding of and devotion to Her and her Immaculate Heart grow like the flowers around us!

How blessed are the young people of our Parish who received the Most Holy Body and Blood of Our Lord in Holy Communion for the first time this weekend! They are blessed because their parents have passed on to them the precious treasure of our faith in Christ, and with the help of their teachers, they have been taught to recognize Christ in the Holy Eucharist and respond to Him with love. Thanks to all who have played a role in bringing them to this important day in their lives. May Christ the Lord - assisted by His holy Mother Mary - keep them always faithful to the Holy Eucharist, the medicine of immortality and the way to rising with Christ to Eternal Life (John 6:54)!

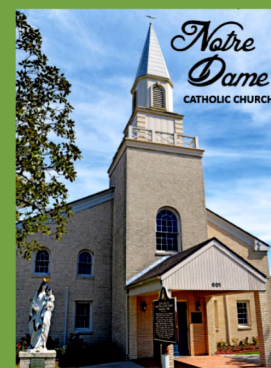

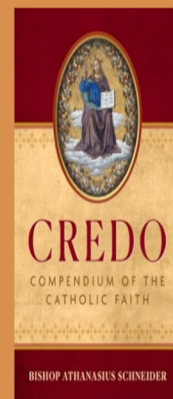

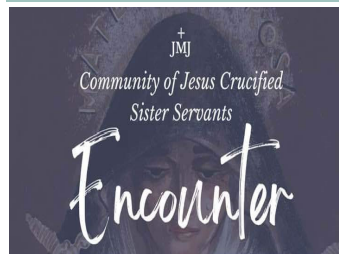
