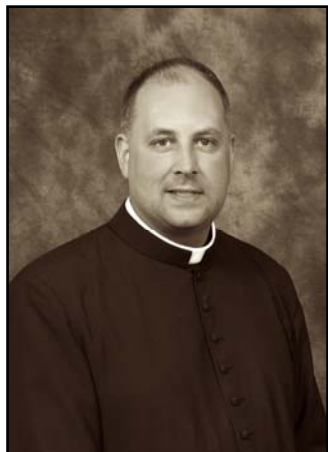

WHO do you say I AM?



~ From the Pastor ~

“My heart's desire and prayer to God for them is that they may be saved.” Romans 10:1

Mes chers amis,

The Gospel today reminds me of a form of artwork that came about in the early centuries of the Church's life and became popular during the Middle Ages: a triptych, from the Greek word meaning “three-fold”. It had three panels, which folded together and were often used as altar paintings, usually containing the Crucifixion, with Christ on the Cross on the middle panel.

What we hear today from St. Mark is like a spiritual triptych. It contains three small sections, and each of them points to a title of Our Lord Jesus. Each tells us something about His person and mission; each is oriented toward His Passion and His saving death on the Cross.

The first title is Messiah, or Christ. It's a scene we know well - described in more detail in Matthew 16. Our Lord asked His disciples, *“Who do people say that I am?”* After hearing the various answers, He asked them directly: *“But who do you say that I am?”* St. Peter answers for the disciples: *“You are the Christ.”* He's the Messiah, long ago foretold and promised by God!

Our Lord then began to teach them about the Passion, death, and Resurrection He would endure, using the second name of the triptych: the Son of Man. On the one hand, it emphasizes the humanity of Christ. But it also refers to the prophet Daniel's vision of the final judgment, when the clouds of Heaven open and *“came one like a son of man, and he came to the Ancient of Days and was presented before him”* (Dan. 7:13). This mysterious figure is also a king who suffers for the sake of the people and who is then glorified by God at the end of time and history, a dramatic event described by Jesus (Matt. 25:31-34) and well as St. John (Rev. 1:12-18). So the name Son of Man refers to both His lowly humanity and His dazzling power.

Finally, we see the third title from the prophet Isaiah and from Our Lord Jesus' teaching about self-denial and taking up the Cross: the Suffering Servant. In today's First reading from the prophet Isaiah, we hear about the man willing to endure torment and mockery for the sake man's sin. The most well-known and full passage is found in Isaiah 52-53, which is read on Good Friday. Jesus made a specific reference to Isaiah's prophecy later in St. Mark's Gospel: *“For the Son of man also came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many”* (Mk. 10:45).

The Messiah (Christ). The Son of Man. The Suffering Servant. Three titles that form a triptych and which reveal to us the truth about Our Lord Jesus and His saving love for us!

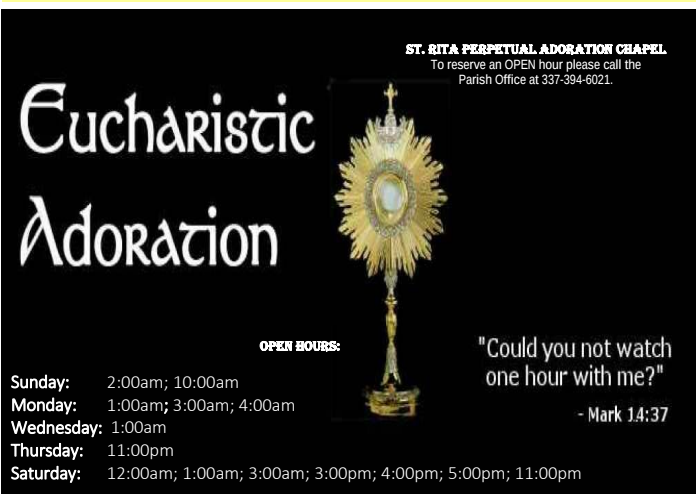

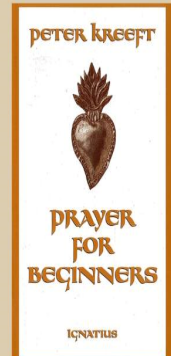

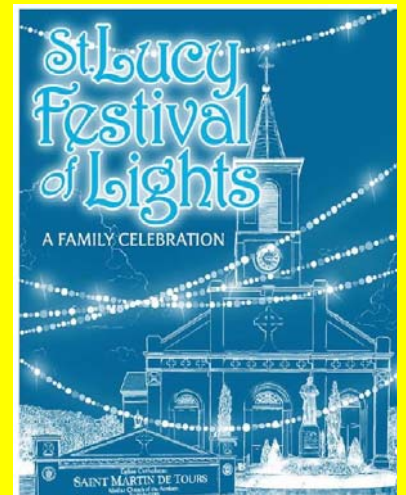

What We're Up To



The year 2033 marks the 2,000th anniversary of our Salvation. To prepare for that momentous jubilee, Bishop Deshotel is inviting the faithful of the Diocese of Lafayette (and beyond!) to join in a [Great Novena](#): starting September 14th with the Feast of the Exaltation of the Cross, we will begin nine years of prayer and reflection to better dispose us to the grace of what God has done for two millennia and what he will do unto eternity.

Poland's Great Novena

1955-1966

9 Years of Grace and Conversion

In 1953 in Poland, Bl. Cardinal Stefan Wyszyński was imprisoned for three years by the occupying Communist regime. The fruit of his prayer in prison was the launch of a nine-year national initiative of prayer and study that would lead up to the 1000th anniversary of the Baptism of Poland in 1966. He named this initiative "The Great Novena." In 1979, St. John Paul II's visit to Poland sparked the Solidarity Movement which would overthrow the regime. It was Cardinal Wyszyński's Great Novena that laid the moral and religious foundation for the success of Solidarity and the liberation of Poland.



In the Diocese of Lafayette, we are seeking a similar grace a renewal, study, and prayer throughout the Diocese through our own "Great Novena" of 9 years in preparation of the Holy Year of 2033, marking 2000 years since the Crucifixion of Christ.

Pray this prayer every day

God our Father, we love and adore You. Although humanity abandoned you through Original Sin in the garden and countless personal sins, you have never abandoned us. We praise you for making us into your beloved sons and daughters. Grant us always to live as your children, seeking your will in all things.

Jesus, Son of God, in this Great Novena leading to the 2,000th anniversary of Your death, resurrection, and ascension into heaven, we trust in Your merciful, personal love. Help us to keep the Great Commission, making a gift of ourselves through great faith, great hope, and great love.

Come, Holy Spirit, renew the face of the earth. As we celebrate the 2,000th anniversary of your descent at Pentecost, give us the gift of communion in the Church, starting with our beloved Diocese of Lafayette, so the world may come to know Jesus, sent by the Father. Make each of us into true disciples of Christ, full of apostolic courage and holy zeal.

Most Holy Trinity and Divine Unity, as we approach the 2,000th anniversary of our salvation, grant through our works, prayers, penances, and studies that your grace may be poured out upon the world in renewed and ever-great abundance. Through Christ our Lord. Amen.
