The Story

"I Remember Mama" made its first appearance on Broadway in 1944, at the Music Box Theatre. Since then, audiences have shared both trials and merriment of the Hanson family through the popular movie and television versions of the play. Mama, Papa, Katrin, Christine, Dagmar, Nels, Uncle Chris, the aunts, relatives and friends of the Hansons live for us in this drama about people in particular situations, seaching for a happy life.

The play was adapted for the stage by John Van Druten from the book, **Mama's Bank Account**, by Kathryn Forbes. The adaption for the stage of this book with its numerous scenes, proved technically challenging and dramatically interesting to the playwright. John Van Druten solved the problem of numerous scene changes through the use of a revolving stage. He gave the play coherence and continuity by using the daughter of the family, Katrin, as narrator. The result is a drama, charming and original.

The action of the play takes place in San Francisco in the year 1910. Mama is the central character, who "can fix everything" for her Norwegian family. Mama's efforts and her family's reaction to them are related in this drama with great warmth and sentiment.
