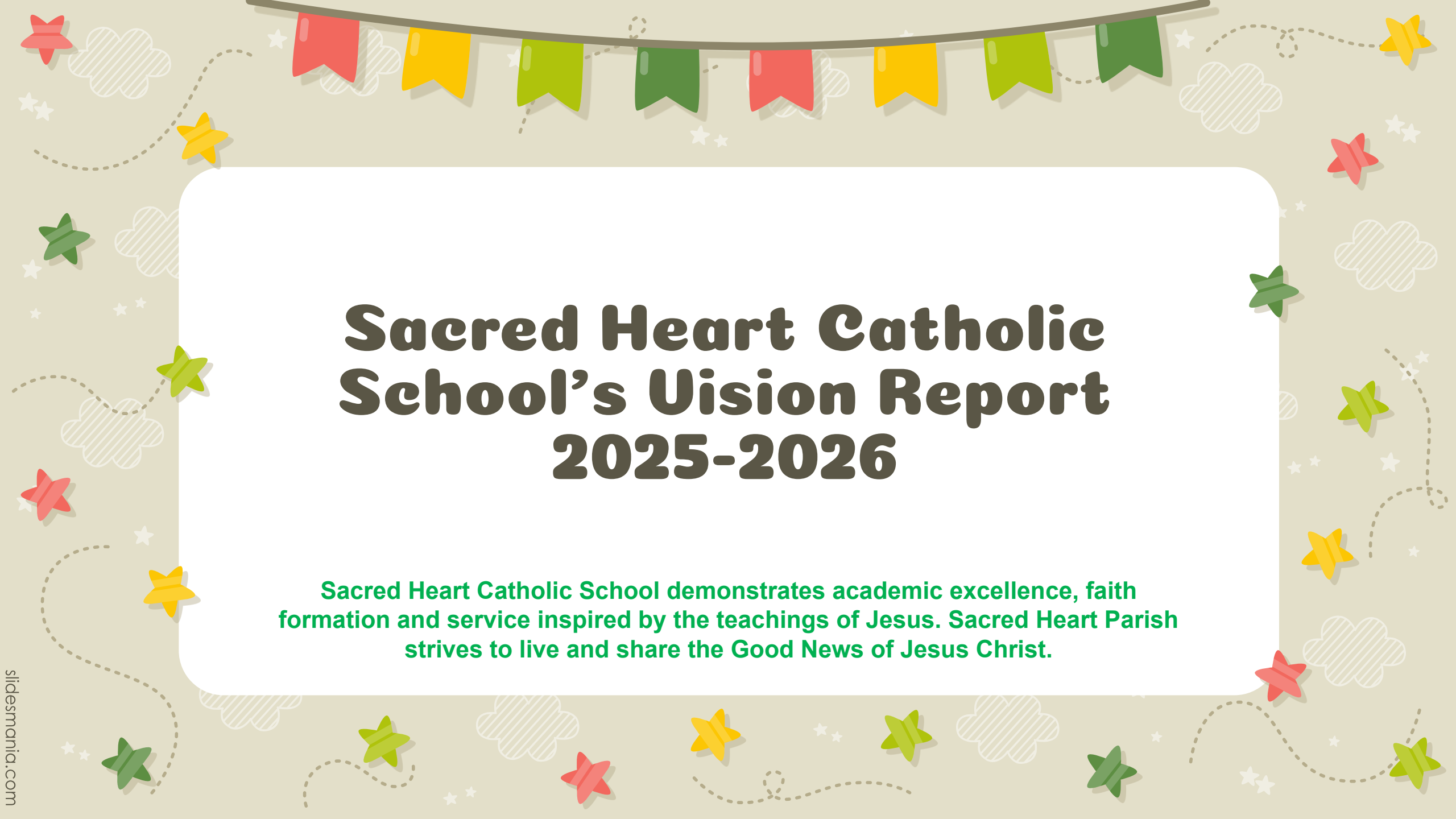




Sacred Heart Catholic School's Uision Report 2025-2026
