Are you a Face Book friend? St. Germaine's page is filled with photos and information about upcoming events that are fun to attend like Trivia Night listed below.

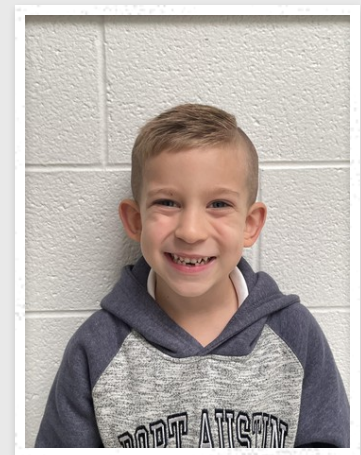
SPARTAN SPOTLIGHT- SPARTAN OF THE WEEK

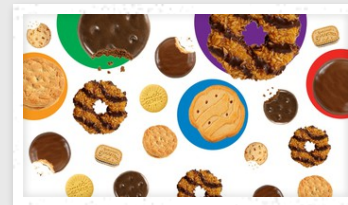
Lucas will be baptized this weekend at St. Germaine, we are proud to welcome him into the church!

LUNCH BUNCH

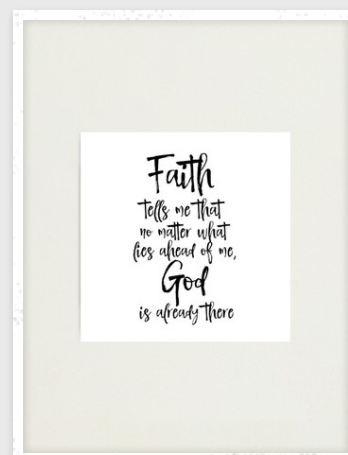

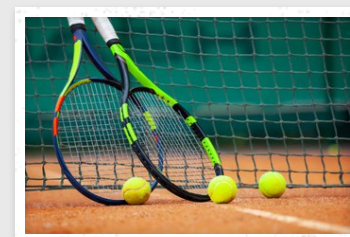
