A message from our principal, Dr. Ulrich:

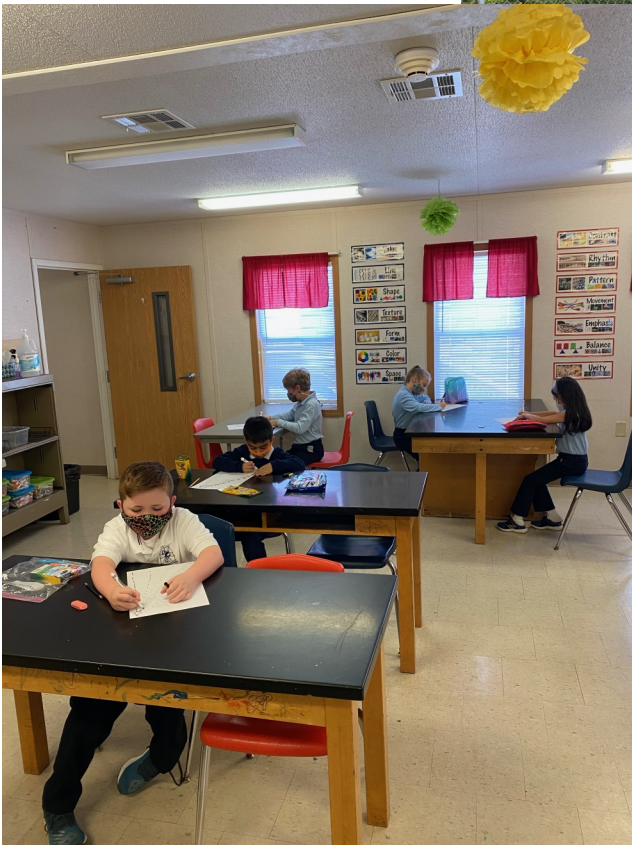
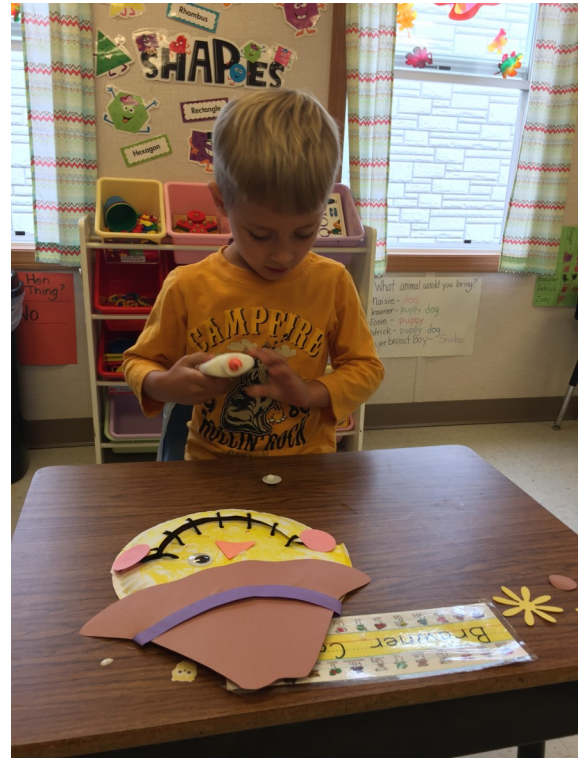
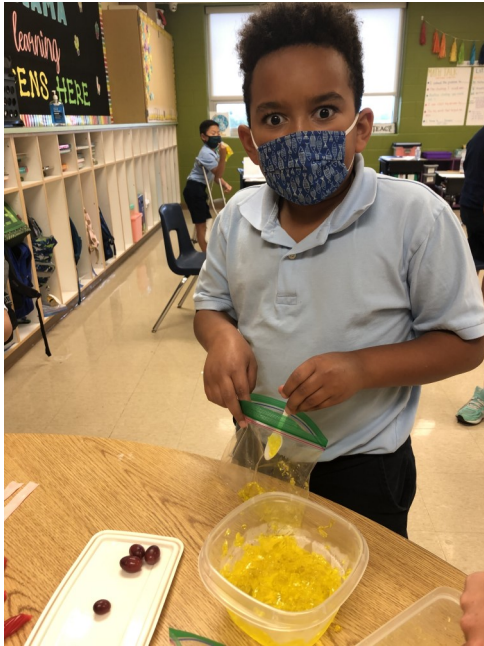
