 - i. Pastor's Report Father John was not in attendance and unable to provide report.
 - ii. Principal's Report Principle Kelly Rowe provided update. Enrollment for 2023-2024 school year is up from last school year with possible student increase of approximately 10% for Pre K and K-8. Pre K class size expected to be no more than 12 per class with 2 adults per class. School considering a grade

4 and 5 split due to class size. Summer camp enrollment going well with full capacity expected between GSS and TFCA enrollees.

Mission in Ministry Grant was approved and will be used to pay for Guidance Counselor. Expecting \$20,000 funding that will have to be reapplied for ongoing. Position will be shared with St. Leo who is providing additional funding of their own. Position expected to host parent information sessions, provide in class guidance, and assist children on an as need basis with personal issues as they arise. Mary Lowe and Kindle Hopkins will not be returning in the 2023-2024 school year. Currently seeking Middle School teacher for Social Studies or Writing. Emily Perkins will be replacing Ms. Hopkins and will be working with Mrs. Coleman on curriculum and Grade 1 readiness.

School Safety Committee Leadership meeting will be in June and will advise when regular meetings to begin with all members.

Adam Scott is stepping down from Athletic Director; pending acceptance from possible candidate. Upcoming school dates: Field day -5/17/2023; Global Village day and 8^{th} Grade clap out 5/18/2023; 8^{th} Grade Graduation -5/19/2023; Last day of school and Pre K Promotion -5/26/2023.

iii. Liaison Reports:

1. PPC – Good Shepherd is hiring a Part Time youth director for the Parish.

2. PTO -

- PTO requesting more parent involvement. PTO sponsored the recent Color Run and has purchased Level Reader books for the school.
- PTO Kickoff event at West 6th Farm in September; planning for a Thursday or Saturday.
- Pool Party cannot be held at Juniper Hills this year but will be held at Falling Springs in Versailles. Planned for the first weekend of August.

iv. School Council Members Updates –

- Butterfly Garden is in place
- Scouts BSA Charter has been approved for GSS and Pack 269 will begin in the Fall.
- Patrick Rupinen attended Diocese Counsel Meeting during the prior week. Advised that Diocese school enrollment and capacity is up overall. School action plans are currently under review. Lexington Catholic to undergo a review from 3rd Party Agency to help determine the best administrative model and define roles and responsibilities within the school.
- GSS expected to host 2023-2024 Focus Forward conference which will include reimbursement for use of the school for meeting space.
