### **PreK-3:(THE BEGINNING TO LAYING OUR LEARNING FOUNDATION)**

The PreK-3 program is center-based, giving children the choice to explore art/easel, book/cozy calm area, blocks, dramatic play, musical instruments, puppets, puzzles, math & science areas, and sensory activities each day. Children are taught in individual, small and large group settings, inside and outside the classroom using songs, music & movement, as well as Spanish and Sign Language. Children will gain knowledge and experience in all the developmental areas: Cognitive, Adaptive, Motor, Social & Emotional, and communication over multiple exposures. Our preschool program uses the Kentucky Early Learner goals to plan experiences for children, as well as the “Discovering God’s World” curriculum to plan spiritual experiences for children.

### **PreK-4: (LAYING OUR LONG-TERM LEARNING FOUNDATION)**

The PreK-4 program is a rich learning environment that uses themed units to teach children the concepts needed to be successful in kindergarten. The Pre-K4 class is center-based giving children the choice to explore art, blocks, dramatic play, math & science, music, and sensory activities each day. The children develop fine and gross motor skills in individual, small and large group settings, in the classroom and outside the classroom. Children will gain knowledge and experience in all the developmental areas: Cognitive, Adaptive, Motor, Social & Emotional, and Communication over multiple exposures. Some of the cognitive skills, the children will learn the alphabet both sound and recognition, as well as number recognition and counting. The children will practice writing skills daily and learn a few basic sight words. Our preschool program uses the Kentucky Early Learner goals to plan experiences for children, along with the “Discovering God’s World” curriculum to plan spiritual experiences for children. The PreK program will also gain experience in the humanities: Spanish, Music, P.E. and Art with specialized encore teachers.

### **KindeReady: (Promoting and Enhancing Your Child's Development)**

KindeReady serves as a bridge between preschool and kindergarten. It provides students the individual extra time to develop fundamental skills needed for success in a school setting that is appropriate to the student's age and development.

The structure of daily activities is to encourage independence and self-confidence and enhance self-regulation and group cooperation through large group, small group, and one-on-one participation in a variety of hands-on interactive experiences.

Daily activities will incorporate classroom structure; instruction; skill reinforcement in reading readiness, mathematics, writing, science, and social studies; art; fine and gross motor skills; and social/emotional skills, as well as enhancing language development. KindeReady is a class to help bridge the gap and lead the way to your child's success upon entering kindergarten.
