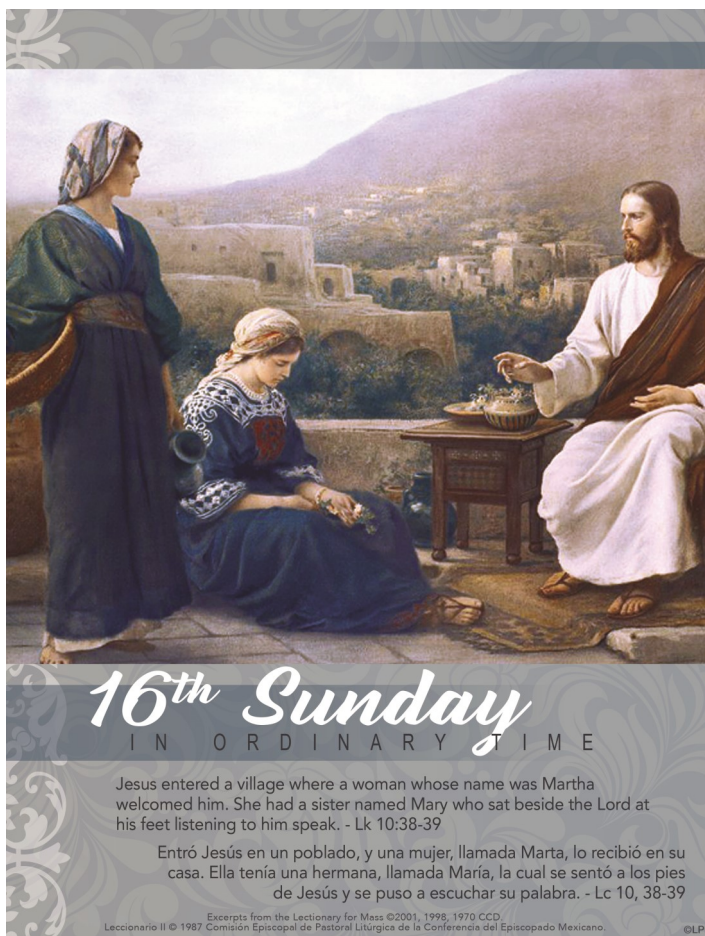

Sacred Conversations

Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Don't you feel sorry for Martha? I wish we knew what she did after Jesus advised her that she was "anxious and worried about many things." Wouldn't it be great to know that she turned off the burners on the stove and sat right down? That, of course, begs the question, "Well, if Mary and the other disciples have chosen the better part, and if Martha should abandon dinner and sit and learn from the Teacher too, who IS going to make dinner?"

I've sort of harrumphed at this story, noting how hungry everyone would be in a few hours if no one was fixing dinner. But Jesus fixes his gaze on me and says, "Stop. Pay attention to what really happened here. Martha was fussing and fuming because Mary wasn't doing what a woman is supposed to do. She was too devoted to me, too in love with the kingdom of God. She was sitting at my feet because that's exactly where I desired her and Martha to be. Remember the scriptures. If you seek me you'll find me if you seek me with all of your heart I will be found by you (Dt. 4:29). But that's not all that Jesus wants us to learn. St. Luke loves stories about women and about meals. During these long weeks of Ordinary Time we'll hear many stories about both, since we're reading Luke all year. Don't miss this one. It's about the discipleship of equals, of course. Mary and Martha have as much right to the Kingdom as do the male disciples. But looking deeper we can glimpse Luke's greatest theme of all: Jesus is the MEAL. Take and eat.

¿No te da lástima Marta? Me encantaría saber qué fue lo que hizo después de que Jesús le señalo que estaba "ansiosa y preocupada por demasiadas cosas." ¿No sería bueno saber que fue y apago los mecheros de la estufa y se sentó inmediatamente?

Y por supuesto, eso nos lleva a otra pregunta, "Bueno, si María y los otros discípulos habían elegido la mejor parte, y si Marta abandonó la cena y se sentó también a aprender del maestro, entonces ¿Quién HIZO la cena?"

Yo he analizado esta historia, fijándome en que tan hambrientos estarían todos en unas horas si nadie se puso a hacer la cena. Pero Jesús fija su mirada en mí y me dice, "Detente. Pon atención en lo que realmente sucedió aquí. Marta estaba refunfuñando y echando chispas porque María no estaba haciendo lo que se supone que las mujeres debían hacer. Ella era muy devota a mí, estaba demasiado enamorada del reino de Dios. Ella estaba postrada a mis pies porque ahí es justamente donde yo quería que ella y Marta estuvieran. Recuerda las escrituras. Si me buscas me encontrarás. Si de verdad me buscas de corazón, permitiré que me encuentres. (Dt. 4:29).

Pero aún hay algo más que Jesús quiere que saquemos de esta historia. A San Lucas le encantan las historias de mujeres y de comidas. Durante estas largas semanas de tiempo ordinario, escucharemos muchas historias más acerca de ambos temas, ya que estamos leyendo San Lucas todo el año. No te pierdas esta. Se trata del discipulado de iguales, por supuesto. María y Marta tienen el mismo derecho al reino que tienen los hombres discípulos. Pero al mirar más a fondo podemos vislumbrar el tema más importante de Lucas: Jesús es la COMIDA. Tomen y coman.

GOSPEL

Active and contemplative. At work and at rest. These are dynamics we all face in our lives, and if we're honest, we might not always balance perfectly! In this Sunday's Gospel, our daily tensions play out in two sisters. Mary "sat beside the Lord at his feet listening to him speak." Martha, on the other hand, is "burdened with much serving." This, as it turns out, is not necessarily "the better part."

All of us reading this have some sort of labor we engage in. We have different trades or careers. We have responsibilities as family members, some of which may take up most of our time. In the time of Scripture, showing hospitality to guests was one of the most important values in society. Our work is important. Jesus himself spent decades as a carpenter. So what's the problem with Martha? Martha is burdened, anxious, and worried. Not only that, but she resents her sister's choice. "Tell her to help me," she demands of Jesus.

How easy it is to get very busy doing good things. We need to provide for our families and plan for retirement. We need to make sure children are clothed, fed, and educated. Our committees, ministries, and sports schedules need to stay on track. However, without a balance of work with rest, without contemplation in the midst of our action, we will miss the point. While many parts are required for our life in the world to function, the better part is our relationship with God. This week, make time in your busy schedule to sit at Jesus' feet. Maybe this is 20 minutes with Scripture, participating in a daily Mass, or a quiet walk alone in the park. Receive what Christ wants to speak to you.
