
















OKTOBERFEST VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

Morning Arrival Route for Drop Off in Front of the School

Vehicles will turn from Hwy. 2854 into the entrance by St. Vincent de Paul and follow the red arrows to the front of the school. Once students have been unloaded in front of the school vehicles will proceed to Madely St. where Officer Martinez will be directing traffic onto Hwy. 2854 to expedite traffic. Vehicles that want to enter the church parking lot after students have been unloaded are asked to use the entrance on Madeley closest to Hwy. 2854.

Drop Off Procedures If Parents Attending Morning Assembly with Students

Travel down Frazier St and turn onto McDade St., then turn right into the first entrance of the church parking lot.

Vehicles will exit the same way. Parents must use the crosswalk and walk students across the crosswalk into the gym.

Be mindful of speed in the church parking lot and of pedestrians in the church parking lot.



2025 - 2026 Afternoon Dismissal Route



To ensure an orderly and speedy dismissal, each family will be given 2 "Family Name" tags to be hung from the rear view mirror. Teachers will be positioned in car line to relay FAMILY NAMES to school personnel who will then arrange for students to be ready for their NAME to be called at dismissal. Additional car tags are \$10.00 each.

The school office must be notified of any carpools, students included in the carpool or any changes to to carpools. A parent must call the school office if a student's dismissal varies from the normal routine. If the office is NOT notified, the student will NOT BE ALLOWED to be dismissed differently.

WEATHER RELATED DISMISSAL

In the event of severe weather (heavy rain/downpours), lightning or heat advisories (temperatures over 95 degrees or heat index over 100 degrees), parents may be required to park and go to classrooms to pick up their children. During severe weather, the safety of our students, staff and members of our school community is our primary concern and takes precedence over convenience.
