GOSPEL MEDITATION

We begin this Holy Week with the reading of the Lord's Passion from the Gospel of Matthew. It is fitting that during this week we intensely focus our minds and hearts on the steps of our Savior as He laid down His very life for us. But let us also examine the seemingly small acts of stewardship by some who encountered Jesus during this most eventful week.

One occurred when Jesus gave instructions about the room where He would celebrate the Passover. Jesus said, "Go into the city to a certain man and tell him..." 'In your house I shall celebrate the Passover with my disciples." While we do not know this man's name, we do know he agreed to this request — he shared the material gift of his home and the gift of hospitality. Because of his good stewardship, his own home became the site of the institution of the Eucharist!

There was also Simon the Cyrenian, who offered the gift of his physical strength, helping the Lord to carry His Cross. Consider, too, the actions of Joseph of Arimathea — he generously shared a material gift of the tomb that was his, and he gave the gift of service to our Lord by giving Him a proper burial. Then there were the "two Marys" who gave Jesus the gift of their time. Keeping watch in tender vigil after His death, they "remained sitting there, facing the tomb."

Each of these were simple acts of good stewardship, yet God used them in mighty ways. God invites each of us, too, to cooperate with Him in small ways through the sharing of our time, talent, and material gifts. Small gifts can become mighty deeds when placed in God's service.

FASTING AND ABSTINENCE FOR GOOD FRIDAY

Abstinence from eating meat on Good Friday is to be observed by all those 14 years old and above.

Fasting is required of those ages 18 -60 years old on Good Friday. Fasting is defined as one full meal and two smaller meals not equaling another full meal together. Snacking is not permitted.

Holy Week Things to Know

Our Holiest Week

Don't miss the best part! As we approach the end of Lent, keep in mind that the liturgical services of the *Triduum* (Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil) are among the very best things we do in the Church. Don't miss these profound and powerful celebrations!



The Latin word "Triduum" refers to the three days prior to the great feast of Easter: Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil. The Triduum emphasizes the sacrificial death of Christ on the Cross. His

Resurrection, and the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist, by which we enter into the life-giving mission of Christ and grow in hope of eternal life.



Holy Thursday, April 6th

Solemn Celebration of the Lord's Supper with Foot Washing and Adoration

St. Ann - 7:00 pm Our Lady - 7:00 pm

Holy Thursday is the commemoration of the Last Supper of Jesus Christ, when He established the sacrament of the Eucharist prior to His arrest and crucifixion. Through word and sacrament, Jesus commands us to love one another and to serve in humility and compassion for others.

After Mass, spend some quiet time in prayer before the Eucharist——a chance to reflect on the mystery of Christ's death and resurrection.

Stations of the Cross (Before Good Friday Service) Friday, April 7th

St. Ann - 11:15 am Our Lady - 2:15 pm

Participate in the Way of the Cross with Jesus and meditate upon His sacrifice of love and His gift of our redemption.



Good Friday, April 7th

Liturgy of the Lord's Passion with Holy Communion.

St. Ann - 12:00 pm Our Lady - 3:00 pm

We continue our Triduum liturgy on Good Friday with reflection on the passion and death of Jesus, veneration of the cross, and a communion service. We refer to this day as "good," because in Christ's suffering and death, God demonstrates His boundless love and forgiveness for each one of us.



Easter Vigil, April 8th for the Collaborative

Held at Our Lady - 9:00 pm

This celebration is the high point of the Triduum. We join in prayer with all Christians celebrating God's covenant with us and recalling His plan for our salvation. We die and rise with Christ in our baptism and profession of faith, and we rejoice in new life surrounded by the symbols of fire, light, oil, water, bread and wine. (There is no Saturday 4:30 pm Mass)
