

MASS BAGS AT ST. ANN

St. Ann offers a wonderful way to keep our littlest ones involved during Mass. Children can find these red Mass Bags at the Welcome Center. Inside you will find books, crayons, spiritual coloring and activity books for our youngest Mass-goers. Please return the bags after Mass. Each Mass Bag is numbered so you can choose to get a Mass Bags new bag every week or grab the bag you enjoyed from a



previous week.



MASS INTENTIONS AVAILABLE

Having a person remembered at Mass in a special way or a 'Mass Intention' is a longstanding tradition in the Catholic Church. An

individual may request a Mass Intention for several reasons: for example, in thanksgiving, for the intentions of another person (such as on a birthday or an anniversary), for someone who is sick, or for the repose of the soul of someone who has died. If you would like to request a Mass Intention for somebody, living or deceased, envelopes can be found at the church entrances or the Welcome Center. Simply fill out the envelope and place your offering inside (usually ten dollars or more). Then return the envelope to the parish office, drop it in the collection basket or leave it with the Welcome Center host. The office staff will schedule the Mass Intention and put it in the bulletin. Special cards are available at the office that can be shared with the family to let them know when this intention will be offered at Mass.

MEIJER HELPS EDWARDSBURG FOOD PANTRY (EFP)

Meijer is collecting donations for their Simply Give program to assist area food pantries. All pantry donations made from July 2 - Sept. 30 at the **Meijer Grape Rd**. store will go directly to our EFP. Meijer will **DOUBLE Match** all donations made on **Sat. August 12 and Sat., Sept. 9**.

Pick up a square "Simply Give Card" located near the cash registers and let the cashier know how much you want to give to the pantry. At the end of the campaign, Meijer will give the EFP gift cards to use to restock the shelves of their food pantry.

MAKING A REPORT OF SEXUAL MISCONDUCT

The Diocese of Kalamazoo has and will continue to cooperate with the Michigan Attorney General's investigation and encourages anyone with information related to misconduct to call the reporting number set up by the Michigan Attorney General's office at (844) 324-3374. The Catholic Bishop Abuse Reporting Service (CBAR) has been established to receive reports of sexual abuse and related misconduct by bishops and to relay those reports to proper Church authorities for investigation. To make a report, visit ReportBishopAbuse.org or phone (800) 276-1562. When a report includes a crime, such as the sexual abuse of a minor, it will also be reported to civil authorities. Otherwise, reports will be kept confidential.


