GOSPEL MEDITATION

31st Sunday in Ordinary Time

There is no question that Jesus had a way with words. The Word of the Lord is filled with what we are very familiar with in our society, soundbites if you will, which convey so much meaning. The last verses of today's Gospel from St. Matthew contain one of those short statements which carry so much more meaning. Jesus says, "The greatest among you must be your servant. Whoever exalts himself will be humbled; but whoever humbles himself will be exalted."

In those two sentences are found the key to a stewardship way of life, which revolves around service and humility. There is no question that these are powerful words. They reveal to us all that we need to understand to be a true disciple of Christ. In his letter to the Philippians St. Paul wrote,

"Though He was in the form of God, He did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross." (Phil. 2:5-8).

True humility will be ultimately exalted by God. Our society teaches us to strive to reach the top, but Jesus is reminding us that we need to regard others as more important than we are. We have two choices in life perhaps, to be self-exalters, or to be God-exalted. Is there any doubt as to what we as Christians should pursue?



THE IMPORTANCE OF PRAYER

Imagine a person who, for years and years, has grabbed coffee and a bagel each morning and then fasted until the next day, taking only sips of



water, juice or soda, maybe grabbing a cracker or a pretzel. And then imagine one day hearing of a new approach to nourishment: something called meals, three times a day. Cereal with milk and coffee in the morning; an entire sandwich for lunchtime; meat, pasta, salad, crusty bread for dinner; and, at bedtime, a piece of apple pie such as you haven't tasted since you were a child.

That comparison comes closest to describing the change in your life once you start praying 20 minutes, four times a day. It gives new meaning to the lyrics: "Taste and see the goodness of the Lord." (Psalm 34:9a)

The change from snatching snacks to sitting down to three meals a day is enormously challenging. It calls for a radical overhaul of your schedule, an uprooting of priorities and commitments, especially, of your mind-set. The preparations take more thought and energy and planning than the prayer. It's like preparing a Thanksgiving dinner. It takes 10 hours to make the meal, and one hour to eat it.

With prayers spaced out throughout the day, we are never far away from God, anticipating the sweetness of our time with Him, looking forward to the resting or the intensity of conversing with the Lord that former prayers had never fostered.

Frequent prayers make sin stand out in stark relief, and instant cries for forgiveness and mercy run throughout the day.

Try including prayer with all meals and snacking. You may find yourself making time to eat those balanced meals...
