The First Reading from Genesis is the infamous story of God putting Abraham to the test. God commands Abraham to handed him over for us all. how offer his son, Isaac, to the Lord as a sacrifice. Abraham obeys the Lord. Yet, a messenger of the God loves us so much that He Lord cries out at the last moment to stop him. Because of Abraham's faithfulness and surrender to the Lord, he is blessed abundantly.

We can only imagine how Abraham felt, offering the life of his son, not understanding why, but blindly obeying. Yet, Abraham's response of total surrender to God's plan is a testament to trust in God's deep love for us. As Christian stewards, we are called to

surrender all to the Lord — our time, our talents, and even our profound love for each one of us. material possessions. We should willingly give God our entire lives with the confidence that He will take care of us.







