As we are now a little more than half way through our school year, it is a good time to review our Covid protocols. For the safety of our students, families and staff, please read and follow this protocol.

#### **COVID Symptom Protocol**

The Illinois Department of Public Health has outlined a decision tree providing guidance on symptomatic individuals and the exclusion policies to follow based on each circumstance. We follow all IDPH guidelines as well as guidelines determined by the Diocese of Rockford. - STAY HOME WHEN SICK If your child exhibits symptoms prior to the start of a school day, please keep your child home and call the office to document the symptoms. The school office appreciates a detailed record of all symptoms. Students displaying covid symptoms while at school will be sent home.
- HEALTH CARE PROVIDER We will be following the IDPH guidance which STRONGLY encourages families to consult with their health care provider about all COVID symptoms and diagnostic testing questions. In order to return to school after symptoms, we will require a consultation with the child's doctor or provider and a note or email from the provider. If there is no follow up with a health care provider, your child will remain out of school for 10 calendar days after the onset of symptoms.
- FEVER If your child is discovered to have a fever during the school day, the parent will be called to pick up the child. Please monitor your child for other symptoms and consult with your child's doctor. If your child is fever free after 48 hours without medicine, he/she may return to school as long as no other symptoms have developed and your child's doctor has approved the return to school.
- VOMITING We know that young children vomit for a variety of reasons that do not often have accompanying symptoms. If your child vomits here at school, the parent will be called to pick up the child. We are extending the stay at home period from 24 to 48 hours after vomiting as long as no other symptoms have developed. This extended time period will enable a parent to look for any new symptoms. If no other symptoms develop, we will not require a doctor's note to return to school.
- SIBLINGS If a child is home sick or sent home from school with fever or vomiting, any siblings here at school will also need to remain home or be sent home for the 48 hour period while monitoring the situation.
- COVID TESTING If a child lives in a household with a member waiting for a test result, or has been in close contact for more than fifteen minutes with any person waiting for results of a Covid test, that child should not return to school until the person tested receives a negative result. If a student is being tested, he/she should not return to school until he/she receives a negative result. If a child has

been in close contact with anyone who receives a positive result, that child may not return to school for at least ten days after the test, assuming the child does not present any symptoms during those ten days. If anyone else in the household tests positive, the ten-day waiting period begins again with that test date. Covid testing is recommended for all close contacts of positive cases, whether or not symptoms are displayed.

## K – 8 Tuition Agreement for 2021 - 2022

As a parent/guardian of a student attending Annunciation School, I agree to the following policies for the 2021 - 2022 school year.

- 1) I will abide by the policies outlined in the Annunciation student handbook and support the administration in enforcing the policies.
- 2) I agree to set up a FACTS Tuition Management account and pay tuition in a timely manner as agreed upon in the FACTS agreement. The FACTS system will be available in March.
- 3) I agree to pay a **non-refundable registration fee** (see chart) due April 1, 2021 on my FACTS account to be created in March.
- 3) I agree to pay the **technology fee** of \$150 by August 1, 2021 on my FACTS account.
- 4) I agree to pay the **family fundraising fee** of \$175 by October 31, 2021 on my FACTS account.
- 5) I understand that if I have a temporary problem with tuition payments, I can make reasonable arrangements with administration BEFORE the next payment deadline.
- 6) The tuition account of an 8<sup>th</sup> grade student must be paid by May 15 in order for the student to attend graduation ceremonies.

#### **Annunciation Preschool Tuition Agreement for 2021 – 2022**

Annunciation School offers a 5 day or 3day (half and full) 4-year-old preschool program with an emphasis on Kindergarten readiness. Lessons are reinforced through small group centers with a focus on socialization and learning how "to do school".

As a parent of a preschool student at Annunciation, I agree to the following:

- 1) I will follow all procedures outlined in the Annunciation student handbook.
- 2) I agree to pay a **non-refundable registration fee** (see chart) at the time of registration.
- 3) I agree to set up a FACTS Tuition Management account and pay tuition in a timely manner agreed upon in the FACTS agreement. The FACTS system will be available in March.
- 4) I understand that if I have a temporary problem with tuition payments, I can make reasonable arrangements with administration BEFORE the next payment deadline.
- 5) \*I understand that a technology fee is charged for my preschooler only if I have no students in grades K 8.
- 6) I understand that all required paperwork must be submitted to the office before my registration is complete. This paperwork will be sent home at a later date.
