Milk distribution for the rest of the year will begin on February 23, 2021. Milk is available in one half pint cartons of low fat chocolate milk or 1% white milk. Students may order two cartons of milk, and these cartons do not have to be of the same type.

Milk orders will be taken on SchoolSpeak through Monday, February 22nd, 2020. The cost for milk is \$28.00 for the period of February 23 – June 2nd, which is approximately 43 cents per day. A convenience fee will be applied.

Please do not miss the order deadline of February 22. Please note, if we should have to return to remote learning at any point, refunds for unused milk will not be issued.


