Starting March 1, our students in grades three through eight will be taking the Iowa Test of Basic Skills. Grades 3, 5, and 7 will also take the Cognitive Ability Test. The diocese has decided that these tests will be given in the spring each year instead of the fall. In preparation for these tests, we recommend a good night's sleep, a healthy breakfast, and a positive attitude. This year because of the masks, we are asking that no candy be sent to school to be eaten during the testing.

When picking up your child(ren) at the primary building, please make sure you cross the street at the crosswalk with the crossing guard present to direct traffic. That intersection is incredibly busy at the beginning and end of the school day. Using the crossing guard ensures everyone's safety. Thank you for following safety protocols.

Home and School is having an open meeting next Tuesday, March 2 at 6:30 at school. Anyone interested in becoming part of this important committee is welcome to come.

Milk distribution for the rest of the year began yesterday, February 23, 2021. If you would still like to order milk for your child, you may do so through today, Wednesday, February 24 on SchoolSpeak.



Milk is available in one half pint cartons of low fat chocolate milk or 1% white milk. Students may order two cartons of milk, and these cartons do not have to be of the same type.

The cost for milk is \$28.00 for the period of February 23 – June 2^{nd} , which is approximately 43 cents per day. A convenience fee will be applied.

Please note, if we should have to return to remote learning at any point, refunds for unused milk will not be issued.


