# How to use the "Little Blue Book": Advent Book

Each 24-hour day has 1,440 minutes. You're asked to give six of those 1,440 minutes to prayer for the next 43 days. People who pray regularly will tell you that it works best if you do it at a set time every day. The main thing is to make it part of your schedule, not something you try to squeeze in whenever. The left-hand page is like a buffet table with a variety of thoughts about the Advent and Christmas seasons, the feast of the day, or various traditions and customs. The key is the right-hand page where we'll reflect on a Gospel passage. Look for these books at the main church entrance the weekend of November 29 & 30<sup>th</sup>. A suggested donation \$1.00.
