

FROM THE DEACON'S DESK.....




As we are well into the Advent season, you have no doubt heard the song "The Twelve Days of Christmas" by now. This is, of course a

If you feel that it is in your heart to contribute to the construction of the Fr. Tony Birdsall Prayer and Reflection garden, please contact me for additional information.


