

Nicaragua Adult Immersion Mission Trip 2018

What does the Lord require of you?

Ever since 2012, we've been bringing a group of adults to Nicaragua for a 3rd-world immersion mission experience. To say that it's a life-changing experience would be an understatement.

Maybe, just maybe, God is calling you to serve in Nicaragua in January...

We work with Catholic Sisters who run an organization called Tepeyac-Nicaragua Foundation. The goal is to bring aid and relief to the poor and distressed people located in the rural areas of Nicaragua. We will be working in a medical clinic, school, and community center. We will teach people how to prevent illnesses and be more self-sufficient. We also will be putting on workshops on how to treat water, keep clean, wash hands, brush teeth, cook food, treat residual water, separate garbage and recycle, create compost, keep domestic animals, etc. For those who are able, we will be doing some rebuilding projects as well. We will also just spend time with the people, playing games, teaching English!


The Sisters guide visitors into the lives of those who are most in need. They include people like *Alejandro*, a young man who was paralyzed from a fall, *Chipito*, a young boy with severe disabilities, along with his sister and nieces who lived in substandard housing, as well as many others in the community. The Sisters enable people to meet, enter into each other's stories and thus expand our awareness of how God moves among us and calls us to live our faith.

In **2018** a team of people will once again visit Tepayac and take part in outreach to the surrounding community. The dates chosen for the visit are **January 31-February 8**. The cost for accommodations, meals, airfare, translators, history presentation, and local excursions is \$1500. (Fundraising can be discussed/an option). Space is limited to 12 people.
