LITURGICAL SCHEDULE

Update: The church will be open to pray Monday through Friday 8-4pm. We ask that you wear a mask, sanitize your hands upon entering (sanitizer stations available at church entrance), do social distancing and maintain the 10 and under rule for your safety. Please enter through the main church doors (Juniper Street).

*Holy Name of Mary Church will be open to pray Mon.-Fri. 9:30-4pm. We ask that you wear a mask, sanitize your hands upon entering (station by door), practice social distancing, and maintain 10 people or less. Enter through the Southeast door (with the ramp) from the parking lot.

Due to the coronavirus, Bishop Ricken, has suspended/cancelled all public Masses until further notice. Bishop will celebrate a 30 minute Mass each Sunday during the suspension of public attendance and it will be broadcast over the local CBS affiliate, WFRV Local 5 at 10:30 a.m. Sunday Mass is also available diocesan-wide via broadcast television on ABC affiliate WBAY at 5:30 a.m. Sunday morning, and on CW14 at 8:00 am. Radio Mass is available on Relevant Radio, 1050 AM at 9 a.m.

Fr. Ryan's Homilies




