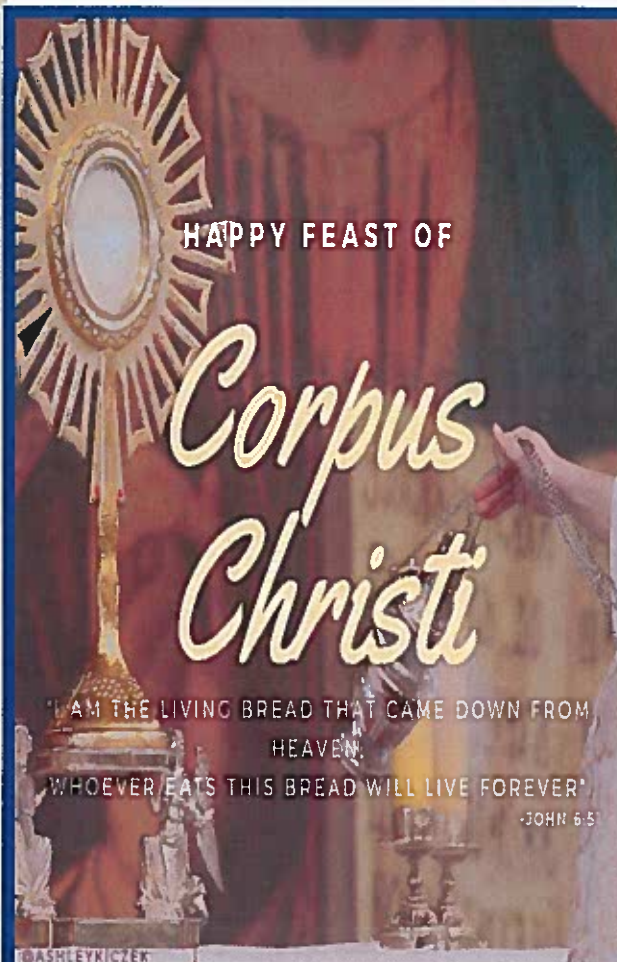

Locked Drop Boxes

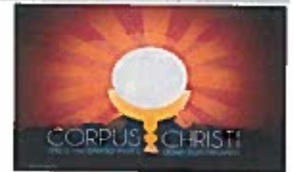

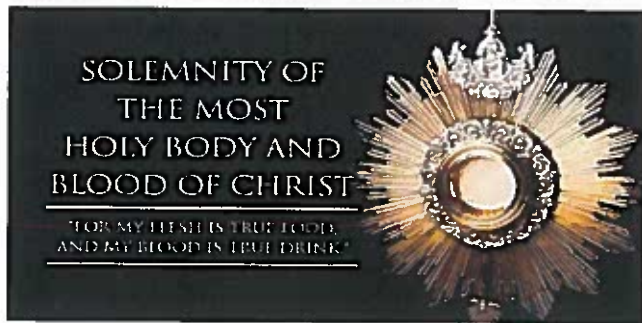
