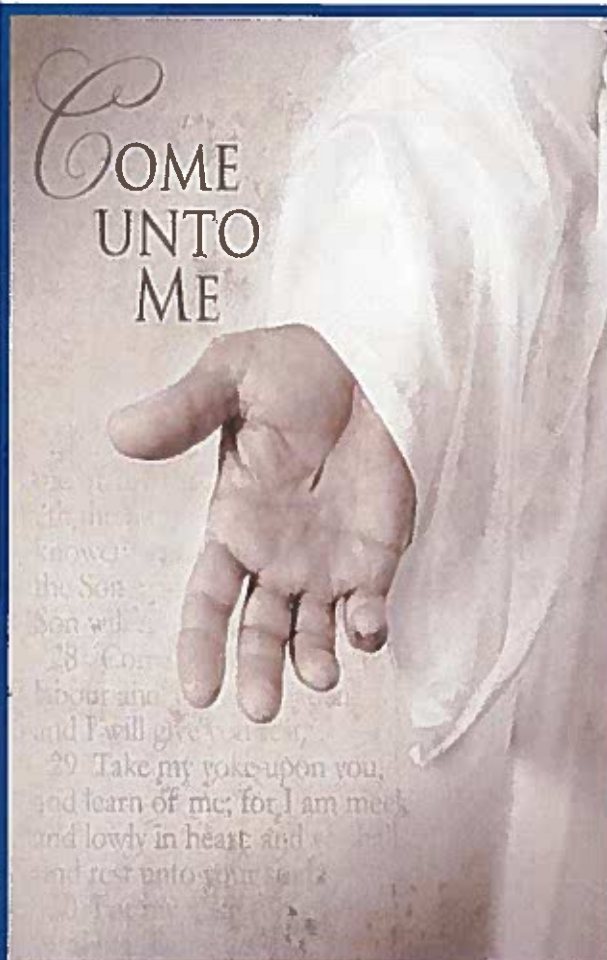

From the Principal

Our School Closed but Learning Continued

Our Bosco Learning Community is steadfastly committed to the education of our children and has always gone the extra mile. So, it was no surprise that our community courageously stepped up to the challenge of transforming SJB to a complete distance learning school literally overnight when we were asked to close in mid-March. Everyone's continued support of this endeavor had an energizing effect on all. Quantum PC, our technology company, worked into the wee hours of the morning to set up our devices for Zoom and our classes in Office 365. Teachers were trained and our on-line learning platform was set for face to face instruction in a day. Thankfully, everyone had their own device for on-line learning. At the 5-8 level students were taught by their various teachers as they followed their usual schedule. If 6th grade science was scheduled from 8:03 - 8:46 they saw their science teacher during that time. If math was scheduled from 8:46 - 9:29 they saw their math teacher. Time was more discretionary for music, physical education and religion with students being able to view videos and do their work at another time. The 8:00-3:00 student schedule worked very well for many, for others there was some difficulty. At the 4K - 4 level,

teachers were able to do guided reading and math with small groups of students one time per day. Additional learning packets were dropped off at students homes every two weeks for follow up work in those academic areas as well as religion, social studies, science, and writing. Again, for many families this worked well and for others there was difficulty. The family survey sent out had varied messages depending on each family as well as each student within that family. While overall successful, all agree the students need to be in our school building. They do better academically with their teachers motivating and helping them with their learning and their classmates interacting with them. Over summer vacation I will be working with our learning community to put into place a smooth opening to the new academic year and setting the priorities to build upon the successes of the school so we can improve. We should always seek to do better; to challenge ourselves and our students to set the highest standards and achieve our ambitious goals. We have learned a lot these past few months and will continue to learn more in the months ahead. We will continue to look at the opportunities that present themselves as we change and grow.
