



Next Weekend: Missionary Cooperation Plan Collection Please use the envelope in this bulletin for the Missionary Cooperation Plan Collection next weekend. Just place the envelope in the basket with the weekly collection. We also welcome Fr. Hilary Brzezinski, OFM next weekend at all our Masses. He is a native of Wausau. He entered the Franciscan Order in the Assumption BVM Province in 1968 and was ordained a priest in 1976. He has ministered in several home missions with Native Americans in Chinle, AZ, African-Americans and Hispanics in Greenwood, MS, and Port Ministries in Chicago, IL. He currently ministers as chaplain to the Franciscan Sisters of Christian Charity in Manitowoc, WI.

The Founder of the Franciscan Order, St. Francis of Assisi, was the first founder of a religious Order to treat in his Rule of Life of mission to non-Christians. He was the first founder to go himself and to send others. Motivated by St. Francis' charisma, Franciscans quickly spread to different parts of the world to evangelize it. Until this day, Franciscans are found in most countries of the world and still serve as missionaries. The Franciscan Friars of the Assumption BVM Province with headquarters in Franklin. Wisconsin are privileged to participate in the Church's mission to proclaim the gospel to all nations. Currently our brothers serve in Jamaica; Greenwood, MS; and Edinburgh, TX. In Greenwood, the mission consists of a parish and school serving the African-American and Hispanic populations of that city. In Edinburg, the mission consists of a Hispanic parish and ministering with the new immigrant population. In addition, our Office of Evangelization still offers financial support to the Franciscan Province of St. Peter Baptist in the Philippines where our brothers served for many years. Our brothers in the ministry of missionary evangelization depend upon our support.
