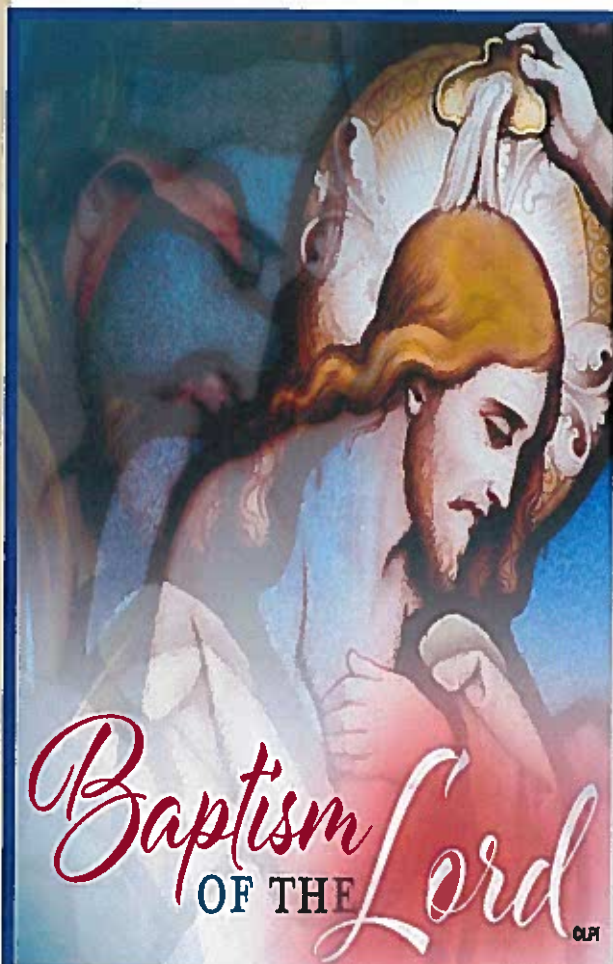

The Courthouse symbolizes that abortion became legal with our Supreme Court's decision in 1973 (48 years ago); the Hospital symbolizes a life Saving facility in CONTRAST to the massive killing taking place legally. Those of us who believe in the RIGHT TO LIFE acknowledge and applaud our local hospital's policy against abortions.

This is not a "Protest March" (No Signs please) but a **Silent Candlelight Walk**. Pray silently or else just walk in silence. Bring your own lantern or a candle (enclosed in a jar for a windbreak). Everyone is welcome, including children. Dress warmly and listen to local radio in case of a cancellation for bad weather. If it's canceled, we will reschedule for the next night, Jan. 22nd.
