

Parishioner Envelopes



Silent CANDLELIGHT Walk

Destination: Door County Medical Center (Hospital)

You are invited to join us as we walk in silence carrying a candle from the Government Center to the Hospital. The Courthouse symbolizes that abortion became legal with our Supreme Court's decision in 1973 (48 years ago); the Hospital symbolizes a life Saving facility in CONTRAST to the massive killing taking place legally. Those of us who believe in the RIGHT TO LIFE acknowledge and applaud our local hospital's policy against abortions.

This is not a "Protest March" (No Signs please) but a Silent Candlelight Walk. Pray silently or else just walk in silence. Bring your own lantern or a candle (enclosed in a jar for a windbreak). Everyone is welcome, including children. Dress warmly and listen to local radio in case of a cancellation for bad weather. If it's canceled, we will reschedule for the next night, Jan. 22nd.

Anyone who CANNOT WALK with us is asked to place a candle in their window the night of the walk & join us in prayer.


