

Lenten Regulations

Each Catholic is asked to preserve the penitential purpose and character of Lent, which begins

Ash Wednesday. Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays in Lent and Good Friday. In addition to abstaining from meat, Catholics who have celebrated their 18th birthday until 59th birthday are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Those who are bound to this regulation should eat only one full meal. Two smaller ones are permitted only if needed to maintain strength.


Bishop's Appeal


