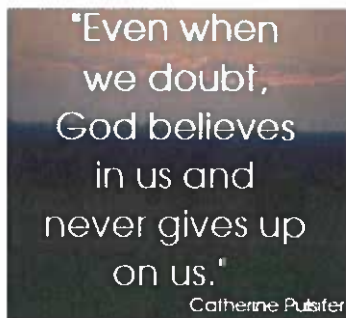

Parish Maintenance Coordinator Job Description

Reports to: Pastor/Administrator, or designee

Objectives: The Parish Maintenance Coordinator is responsible for the oversight of parish facilities, equipment and grounds, including performing regular facility inspection to identify both major and minor maintenance concerns. The Maintenance Coordinator attends committee meetings and works with Buildings & Grounds Committee members, parish staff and outside contractors.

A successful candidate must understand that safety regulatory compliance is a priority ensuring compliance with federal, state and local facility/licensing and environmental regulations. The Maintenance Coordinator is responsible for preventative maintenance and repair on facility and equipment, maintains an orderly work area and assists parish custodial staff for parish event set-up/tear down assignments as well as other cleaning/organizing functions. Other duties as assigned by the Pastor/Parish Administrator or designee.

Compensation: Parish Finance Council determines wage/benefit package.

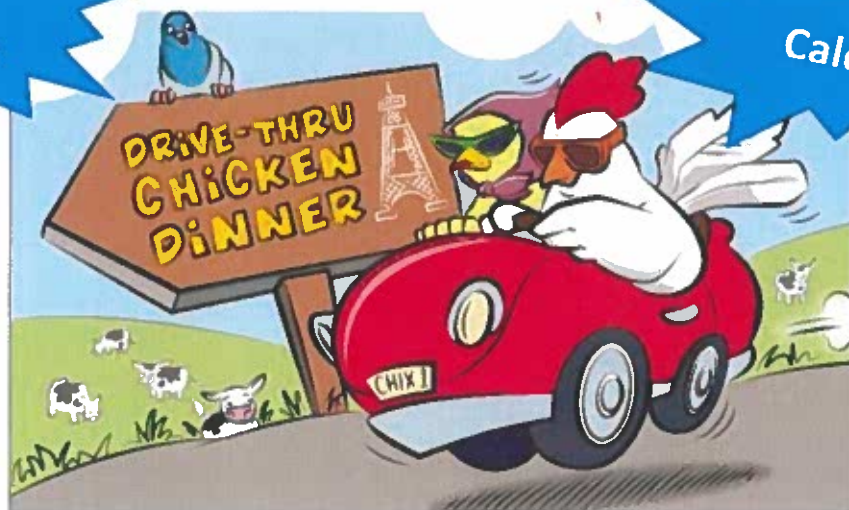
Qualifications: An ideal candidate will possess skills and/or knowledge in a variety of maintenance areas, including HVAC, electrical, plumbing, and general carpentry/constructions. Experience in the operation of basic power tools is required. Ability to coordinate with lawn care/snow removal contractors as well as operate and maintain lawn tractor and snow blower. High School diploma or G.E.D. / H.S.E.D certificate is required.

Working hours: Normal working hours are 20 hours/week during the daytime Monday through Friday. Some flexibility is required due to weekend activities.

Physical requirements: Standing, pushing, pulling, walking, stooping, kneeling, carrying, ladder climbing, for part of or full shift may be required. Working in winter cold or summer heat for part of or full shift may be required. Ability to lift up to 25 pounds regularly and up to 50 pounds occasionally may be required.
