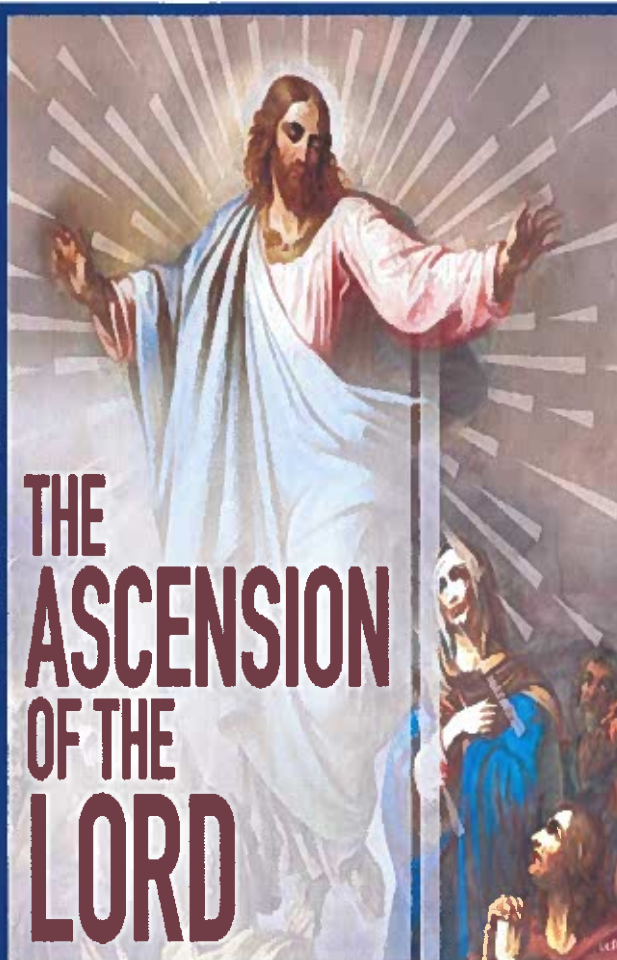

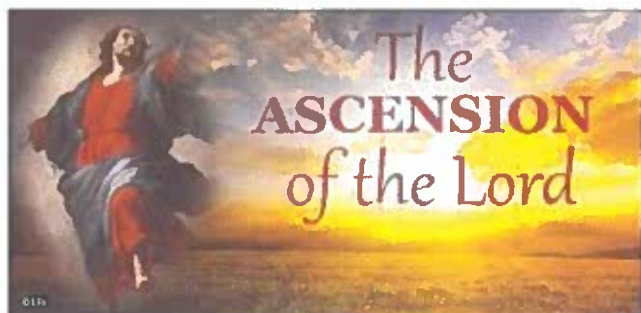
Bishop's Appeal

Corpus Christi: Maintenance Coordinator Opportunity

The Parish Maintenance Coordinator is responsible for the over-sight of parish facilities, equipment and grounds including performing regular facility inspection to identify both major and minor maintenance concerns. Other responsibilities include preventative maintenance and repair on facility and equipment, assisting with parish event set-up/tear down assignments and other cleaning/organizing functions. The Maintenance Coordinator works with outside contractors, the Buildings & Grounds Committee, and parish staff. Normal working hours are 20 hours/week during the daytime Monday through Friday. This collection has 4 major beneficiaries represented:

Black and Indian Missions-exist to build Christian communities among the Native American, African American and Alaskan Native people in the United States. Know that every penny collected is distributed as diocesan grants to support and strength evangelization programs.

The Catholic Communications Campaign-connects people to Christ through internet, television, radio and print. They connect people to Christ to spread the Gospel message locally and nationally. Half of all funds collected remain in our diocese to support our local communications efforts.

The Catholic University of America- is the National University of the Catholic Church. Your gift helps prepare the next generation in Catholic leadership, both religious and lay. Alumni include 19 living Cardinals, 58 Bishops and over 12,500 priests.

To say it's been a challenging year would be an understatement. All of us faced different challenges during the pandemic. I remember last year when the pandemic began and we were all to stay at home. We knew right away that we could not just cancel youth ministry. I remember researching and trying to find the best virtual platform for the youth. Zoom seemed so foreign to me, but I was willing to learn something new so we could still "meet." It was so hard. I was struggling with anxiety and uncertainty. It was hard to have a message of hope for our young people. But you know what? I remember saying to God, "God, you've got this. You're in control. Help me and my Core Team love our young Church." I'm always amazed at what happens when I give up control and let God be God!

At the beginning of the 2020-21 school year, we wanted to gather in person in small groups (masked and distanced) but the COVID numbers were skyrocketing. So we stayed online. Something very positive about Zoom: I was able to just be present with the young people. I didn't have to worry about setting up the next activity or making copies, I was present to them and got to know them better. I am so thankful for those relationships.

I want to thank our Core Team for always being positive and willing to try new things in the face of a challenging year. I am so thankful for them.
