

#### Bishop's Appeal



#### Corpus Christi: Maintenance Coordinator Opportunity

Other responsibilities include preventative maintenance and repair on facility and equipment, assisting with parish event set-up/tear down assignments and other cleaning/organizing functions. The Maintenance Coordinator works with outside contractors, the Buildings & Grounds Committee, and parish staff. Normal working hours are 20 hours/week during the daytime Monday through Friday. This collection has 4 major beneficiaries represented:



To say it's been a challenging year would be an understatement. All of us faced different challenges during the pandemic. I remember last year when the pandemic began and we were all to stay at home. We knew right away that we could not just cancel youth ministry. I remember researching and trying to find the best virtual platform for the youth. Zoom seemed so foreign to me, but I was willing to learn something new so we could still "meet." It was so hard. I was struggling with anxiety and uncertainty. It was hard to have a message of hope for our young people. But you know what? I remember saying to God, "God, you've got this. You're in control. Help me and my Core Team love our young Church."
