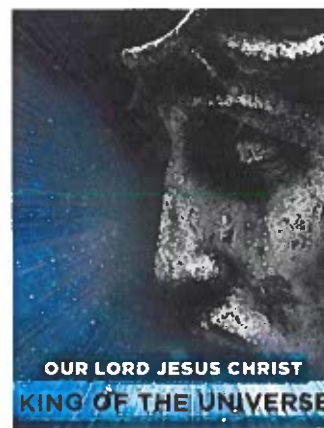
The Solemnity of Christ the King

As cultures around the world seem to be growing more secularized, and as some Christians are denounced for proclaiming the Gospel, we need to be seen and heard as devoted followers of Jesus Christ.

Back in 1925, Pope Pius XI understood that secularism and atheism was on the rise, and in response to the growing Godless culture, he instituted the feast we celebrate today: The Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, also known as the Feast of Christ the King. A Solemnity is the highest-ranking feast in our liturgical year, 17 of which we celebrate each year. Ten of the 17 feasts celebrate truths of our Lord or the Holy Spirit; three celebrate our Blessed Mother Mary and four celebrate other saints.

Pope Pius XI recognized the culture movement that attempted to cast Jesus Christ and His Holy Gospel out of public and eventually private life as well. Pius XI knew the result would be greater discord among peoples and nations, and that the Church had to respond with truth and power. The truth of Jesus Christ and the Power of God are available to each one of us at Holy Mass. Today's Solemnity reminds us that our Lord reigns as King forever and what our King gives us must be shared with others. Acknowledging Him not only in our private, but our public and social life, as well. We all know members of our community or family who have drifted away from the Church, so let us make a conscientious effort this week to lovingly invite them back as we start a new liturgical year with the first Sunday of Advent. Christ the King is calling us.

The Giving Tree

The Giving Tree is back! It is to look a little bit different this year. We are still helping families, but we are also reaching out to other area nonprofits that are helping those in need. Our youth really

want to focus on the 7 Corporal Works of Mercy (**to feed the hungry, to give drink to the thirsty, to clothe the naked, to give shelter to homeless, to visit the sick, to visit the imprisoned, and to bury the dead**).

As a middle schooler said, "We should help because Jesus told us to; He didn't suggest it, Jesus said we must!"

Your ornament might have a gift request, gift card request or maybe even a monetary donation to businesses/nonprofits. For example, if you see a donation to SBU or WPS, we want to help someone who can't afford to pay their water bill this Christmas.

This is how it works: Pick an ornament off the tree. Each ornament has a request for someone in need in our community. Purchase the gift/gift card that is on the ornament. Please do not lose the ornament! In fact, **we are encouraging everyone to take a picture of it just in case you lose it, you will have the number and gift request!**

November 27th and 28th: Ornaments will be put on the trees. Parishioners are encouraged to take an ornament or two.

Sunday, December 12th by noon—all gift/gift cards are due back (wrapped) to the Giving Tree with the original ornament attached. We ask that all gift cards come back in an envelope.

NO LATE GIFTS PLEASE. We organize and deliver right away so the gifts get to those in need by Christmas.

**Note, whatever is on your ornament is all the information we have. Please attach a gift receipt if you are unsure of sizes.*
