

The Third Sunday of Advent by: Deacon Mark Hibbs

Advent is the certain time of the year when you and I, for four weeks, prepare in a special way for two events. First, Christmas, the coming of Christ into our world; God becoming man. Second, Christ's second coming at the end of time. Every year on the 3rd Sunday of Advent, we celebrate Gaudete (gow-day-tay) Sunday, a day of rejoicing amidst the four weeks of penitential reflection, it's like a gift inside a gift. Gaudete is a Latin word for "rejoice," and it signifies that we are more than halfway to Christmas.

Like a child excited and full of joyful anticipation of the gifts they hope to receive on Christmas morning, we too experience with joyful anticipation the growing presence of Christ Jesus in our lives and in the lives of our loved ones.

This type of rejoicing is palpable because we will soon be together with the one we love and the one who loves us more than anyone else. Just as a bridegroom awaits his bride as she walks down the aisle and her had is put into his, our Lord and Savior's entrance into the world, wrapping us into a mantle of His love and never leaving us.

What event in your life, and I hope there are many, were times of great expectation and joy? Times when your mind and heart were focused on a joyful union or reunion? Perhaps being reunited with your parents or siblings or children after a long absence? Or what about your own wedding or ordination, which are Sacraments of giving yourself to another? Or the birth of your children? These are all times of great expectation, joy, and thanksgiving to God.

Our God is also rejoicing because we His children are preparing for His Son's arrival. With intentional commitments, like the vows a husband and wife make at His Altar, we prepare through prayer, reconciliation, and communion.

Additionally, the vestments for Holy Mass are rose color. This beautiful color represents the anticipation of the event to come and speaks to me of peace, love, and thanksgiving – similar to the birth of a child!

May this week be a special time of rejoicing in our lives as we await Christ's Coming, and may we all be ready to say, "Come Lord Jesus"!!



IRA Charitable Rollover

Please prayerfully consider making a charitable IRA gift this year to Corpus Christi Parish. If you are 70½ or older and own an IRA, please consider making a charitable rollover gift before December 31. You can make a gift up to \$100,000 directly from your IRA to our parish.

Your gift will:

- not be included in your taxable income
- satisfy your required minimum distribution for the year
- reduce your taxable income, even if you do not itemize deductions
- not be subject to the 50% limitation on charitable gifts
- help the work of the Church An IRA charitable rollover is a very simple gift to make.

Please make your gift as soon as possible to avoid any processing delays at the end of the month.
