

GOSPEL MEDITATION


April 23, 2023 Third Sunday of Easter

I always feel a little sad when someone begins to speak to me with the words, "Father, I know you're so busy, but ..." It happens a lot. And I get it. He or she is trying to be respectful of my time. But it saddens me because a priest makes Jesus present to people in a special way, and Jesus always has time for us. Don't we all feel at times that God just doesn't have time for us?

Nonsense. Just look at the stunning "Road to Emmaus" story we hear this week. It's the day Jesus rose from the dead. And the Risen One appears in disguise to two disciples. He walks with them, chats with them, and eventually eats with them. It could have been hours he spends with them — two unnamed persons — in the middle of nowhere. On the day he rose from the dead!

My friends, please take this to heart: The Risen Jesus is not too busy to spend time with you! He doesn't have "better things to do." You and I are members of this crucified and risen Body. He therefore has all the time in the world to be with us. So, I challenge you this week to approach him confidently in prayer and conversation. After all, being with you and me is the reason he rose from the dead.


The Lakeshore Singers Concert & Social

Life Teen Mission Trip 2023 ** Dickinson, TX

Dear Parishioners,

The time has FINALLY arrived—mission trips are BAAAAACK! We have such an amazing group of students attending the mission trip in June. These students want to help, and their service is greatly needed. Dickinson, TX is in dire need. In 2017, Hurricane Harvey devastated their community. 90% of the city was flooded (a city of about 20,000) and 50% was destroyed. They did not receive the help they so desperately needed. They are still dealing with after affects from the terrible hurricane.

Pope Emeritus Benedict said to the young people of the world: "You were not created for comfort but for greatness." Our youth are not looking for someone to offer them an easy life; they are willing to be uncomfortable. Mission trips are life changing because our youth can get away and truly disconnect from their busy lives (phones, internet, work, school, sports). When they disconnect and spend time in a new environment, their eyes are opened to the need around them. And guess what? When their eyes are opened, they can't be closed. It is a fact that students who attend mission trips are more likely to serve locally here in Door County because of their eye-opening experience on mission trips.

Our youth will be working on many different projects from serving meals to helping with construction work. This is anything but a vacation. They will work hard!
