

GOSPEL MEDITATION

November 19, 2023 33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

When I was a kid, I hated playing Monopoly because my siblings and friends always seemed to win. But worse was how it happened. Scared to risk my fake money on buying properties, I'd hold on to it. My opponents hungrily bought up the various real estate squares on the board. Then, inevitably, my poor, low-equity self would land on their spots, pay them rent, and my money would drain to zero. It seemed so unfair. The rich get richer, and the poor get poorer. I had to learn that monopoly money is meant to be spent. I was scared to lose some of it. So, I lost all of it.

How do we see what we possess? Jesus' parable about the talents is not really about economics but about the investability of everything he entrusts to us. How marvelous that everyone in the fable who places talents in the open market doubles their investment. The only one who doesn't is the man who fearfully buries his one talent. Jesus' success strategy for us seems to be, whatever we have, get it out of our possession. Risk it as quickly and as fully as we can.

You and I have precious gifts. We have valuable things to invest — time, talents, treasure. The Lord invites us to be brave and even somewhat reckless, to give as much away as possible. If we give it away in the direction of love and truth, it will grow. If we hold on to it in fear, the little we have will be taken away. Let me challenge you this week: find something in your life you're holding on to, and risk it by giving it away. It won't double if you hold on to it.


Our second Genesis Service Project!

2023 Giving Tree Project is now "Christmas Wish"

For many years, we've had a Giving Tree at our parishes. We are taking a new approach to reach and assist individuals and families in our community by taking steps to better serve those in need this Christmas season. We decided it is a good time to change the name too. Same concept, just a few changes.

Would you like to take part of this project this year?

This is how it works: Pick a heart of the tree or the bulletin board. Each heart has a request for someone in need in our community. Purchase the gift/gift card that is on the heart. You may also choose a heart asking for cash/check donations. (See description below)

Please do not lose the heart! In fact, we are encouraging everyone to take a picture of it just in case you lose it, you will have the number and gift request!

You will have a few options to give this year:

- Financial assistance for groceries.
- Financial assistance: Some people simply cannot afford heat, so we hope to help with their utility/gas/propane bill.
- Gift requests: some of the hearts will have clothing items while others may have a fun toy or something fun. Each person we help will receive clothing AND something fun. If you pick one with clothing, rest assured they will also have something fun to open!

November 25th and 26th Hearts will be put on the trees/ bulletin boards. Parishioners are encouraged to take a heart or two.

<u>Sunday, December 17th noon</u>—all gift/gift cards are due back (wrapped) to the tree/parish <u>with the original heart attached.</u>
