Children's Liturgy of the Word

All first and second graders are invited to participate in Children's Liturgy of the Word (CLOW).

Visitors to our parish are always welcomed.

CLOW is offered at the Saturday 5 PM, Sunday 9 & 11 AM Masses. Children are invited up to the steps, and given a blessing by the priest. They are then escorted to the West Meeting Room by their leaders.

CLOW is a time of prayer mirroring what is happening in church but on a child's

level. The readings are from the Children's Lectionary using a simpler translation. The readings are discussed and the children pray a Profession of Faith and Prayers of the Faithful. They receive a leaflet to take home and return to church during the Preparation of the Gifts/collection. Participants in CLOW should bring their contribution envelope to CLOW since a special collection basket is presented by the children.



Note that CLOW is a supplement to the religious education they are receiving in Faith Formation or in Catholic School, and **there is no registration and no fee**. CLOW is offered from October thru the weekend before Memorial Day.






