We at St. Vincent have been blessed with a great, big family. Over the life of the parish, we have seen our family grow, but as with any family, change happens. People move and change parishes and we at St. Vincent wanted to have an accurate representation of our family.

Starting in January, we had over 40 volunteers offer to help us call roughly 1100 households. This process was extensive as we focused on trying to engage as many parishioners into the life of our parish. We initially sent out a postcard, followed by one or two, sometimes even three phone calls. Then for those we did not speak to directly, we sent out one final mailing.

Our goal was not to just "clean up the books" but rather to really attempt to get to know our parishioners and make them feel a part of the parish. When we could, we made sure that, we talked to each person and offered to pray for any needs they might have.

During this process we had some incredible conversations. One phone caller spoke with a person who had just lost their dad and was glad for someone to call them and offer prayers. Another phone caller invited a parishioner to a Coffee and Company after Mass to meet them and introduce them to some other people.

In the end we have determined that we are now a parish of 2865 households. Because we had not completed a census clean-up in a long time, we knew that this number would go down significantly. This new number does not change anything for us as a parish, but it gives us a greater understanding of who we are as we plan for the future. We are still growing as a parish, however. Since January, we have had 113 families join our parish! That is an incredible number!

We want to thank those that helped with this process! It is because of volunteers like you that our parish is the vibrant, welcoming community that it is.

We look to the future with optimism, knowing that it is through the power of the Holy Spirit that we at St. Vincent de Paul continue to be strong. We thank you, our parishioners, for being a part of our family and we look forward to walking with you as we grow in community to Know, Love and Serve Jesus Christ and His Church.
