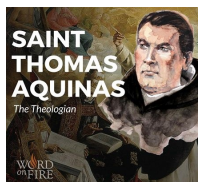

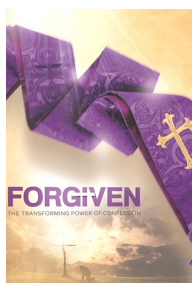

## St. Vincent de Paul & Feed My Starving Children (FMSC) 2017 Summary

May 2017 FMSC recognized SVDP with an "Extraordinary Service Award" for the food packed during 2016 and 2017. The Tuesday morning team is pictured here.



The Tuesday group started May 2007; the Friday group started August 2009. Since 2007/2009, **SVDP volunteers have packed 2,299,104 meals!**\* SVDP members have volunteered for the NW Suburban MobilePack, the St. Paul Civic Center Somali MobilePack, and the Target Field MobilePack.

SVDP second collections for FMSC for 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, **2017** have been \$5,204, \$6,393, \$7,153, \$6,338, \$6,683, \$8,007, \$8,482, \$8,436, **\$6,795.24** respectively. **During 2017, SVDP packed 215,568 meals.**

SVDP donated 998 volunteer hours during 2017, averaging 83 volunteers per month. It takes roughly 1 ton of rice to pack 20,000 meals; SVDP parishioners have used 111 tons of rice over the past ten years – one cup at a time! We continue to get 15 to 20 volunteers to join us for lunch at Dick's Bar and Grill.

*\* FMSC estimates that one volunteer packs one box (216 meals) per volunteer event; on a regular basis 1 witness that SVDP volunteers pack 2 boxes per visit.*

### Facts about FMSC-

- Fiscal year ending February 2017 – FMSC provided 779,074 meals to God's hungry children daily packing 284,362,320 meals with 1,000,000 volunteer events; 251 mobile packs in 37 states across the United States packing 65 million meals; 99.8% meals arrive at their intended destination.
- Each meal has 20 different vitamins and minerals that are specifically tailored to meet a child's nutritional needs for one day. Each meal currently costs \$.22.
- FMSC has shipped food to 58 countries leveraging 89 established distribution partners. FMSC packs the food (\$60,000 per container) and FMSC's partners pay for shipment (\$10,000).
