



What's up with that prayer?

The Eucharistic prayer is the prayer that the priest prays after we all sing "Holy, Holy, Holy..." and ends when the priest (with the assistance of the deacon when he's present)



elevates the paten (small plate with Eucharist on it) and chalice (cup with the Precious Blood in it) while singing or saying, "Through Him, with Him, and in Him..." to which the people respond "Amen." By saying this prayer over the bread and wine they become the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ.

There are at least 10 different Eucharistic prayers that a priest can use, though some are only to be used for certain purposes (e.g. in time of war, specifically for the pope, etc.) The Eucharistic prayer that I prefer to use is known as Eucharistic Prayer I or the Roman Canon.

Why do I use this prayer? There are several reasons. Catholics have been praying this prayer for a long time, and it is good whenever we can be reminded that we believe the same faith and pray the same prayers as those who have gone before us because it shows us the unchanging nature of the faith; Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.

The unchanging and constant nature of the faith is also reflected by the two lists of saints that are included in the prayer, one at the beginning, and another at the end. You probably recognize the names of some of these saints, such as Mary, Joseph, and the 12 apostles. The other saints mentioned are all from the early days of the Church, many of them having died in witness to the faith. This reminds us in very real way that the same faith we believe was active in the earliest believers in the Church, and it is through their witness to the faith, especially those who gave their life in martyrdom, that we are able to partake in that same faith and the fruit it brings about to this very day. This is an encouragement for us all to continue to witness to the faith as these early saints did so that future generations can know and love Jesus Christ and His Church! - Fr. Paul Baker


Thank You to the 1054 families who have contributed so generously to our campaign.


