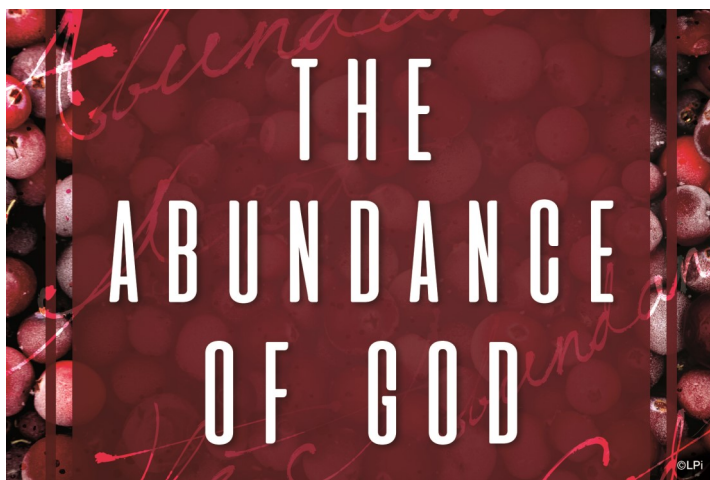

## To the Parents of our Youngest Parishioners:

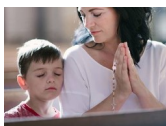
**God put the wiggle in

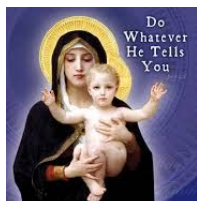
