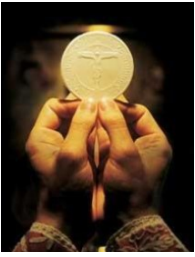

Bring our Gifts Forward

Families and groups of individuals can arrange in advance to perform the role of



“Gift Bearer” at Mass. The normal practice is to have three people act as a team to bring forward the gifts of wine, water, and bread to present to the Presider at Mass. It is a great way to help celebrate a birthday, anniversary, graduation, or other memorable event. Reservations may be made at the Church Office during regular office hours, and may be made for a specific date and Mass time, up to one year in advance. We will “book” the reservation with contact information.

A family or group can always cancel a reservation. The Reservations will be posted Friday afternoon in the Usher Room. The Family/Group must sit near the gifts table. **The Family/Group should introduce themselves to the usher nearest the main doors 10 minutes prior to the beginning of Mass.** The usher will remind them of their duties. If no Family/Group that has a reservation has made it known that they are present with less than 10 minutes before Mass, then the usher will select other persons to fulfill this role.

From our Pastor



Coming back from Italy I was reminded how disorienting jet lag can be. Am I hungry or tired? Am I supposed to be? Should I have a burger and a beer or a bagel with coffee? If I doze off will I stay asleep for ten minutes or ten hours? I want to know what normal feels like again.

Christmas music in November also is disorienting. Christmas music, no. Just, no. As much as we like you, it's not that time. Don't make us forget what time it is. Don't make us forget what's normal.

Since the great fall of Adam and Eve our world has experienced something like jet lag. We're disoriented from the eternal and true. We've forgotten what's normal. It's normal to pray and be with God. It's normal to respect and enjoy the proper times and seasons that He gives us. There's a normal order for how we use our bodies and minds. "Woe to those who call evil good and good evil, who change darkness into light and light into darkness" (Isaiah 5:20). We need to remember what normal feels like.

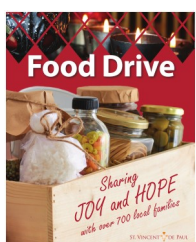

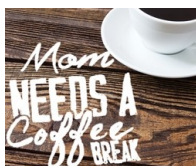
