The best Christmas Bazaar is here at St. Vincent de Paul, and you don't want to miss it.





I just watched some old YouTube clips from the animated classic, "A Charlie Brown Thanksgiving." I love the moment, right after Snoopy brings the food to the table, when Peppermint Patty suggests that somebody should say grace before



they eat. The first reaction comes from Snoopy. He gets a panicked look on his face that seems to say, "Dear God, please, not me. Let somebody else say the prayer."




The Book Fair is this weekend after all Masses
