





Be sure to get here early to get one of the many Christmas



Join in Adoration to End Abortion

Up to and including December 1, 2021

Join Catholics across the country in Eucharistic Adoration before and on December 1, when the Supreme Court hears the landmark pro-life case, Dobbs vs Jackson Women's Health. In the Dobbs case, the Supreme Court has to decide the constitutionality of a 2018 state law that bans most abortions after 15 weeks of gestation in Mississippi.

Abortion groups have challenged this law ever since it passed. The Supreme Court's ruling on Dobbs could amount to a ruling on the constitutionality of Roe v. Wade itself.

Please consider devoting some time in prayer before the True Presence of Jesus in our Adoration Chapel, open every day for our parishioners to draw close to Jesus and pray.


Festival Children's Choir to sing at the 4 PM **Christmas Eve Mass** on Friday. Dec. 24
