I have been re-reading one of my favorite novels – “Brideshead Revisited” by Evelyn Waugh. In one passage Julia speaks of her failed relationship with Rex. She said, “Father Mowbray hit on the truth about Rex... He simply wasn't all there. He wasn't a complete human being at all... he was something absolutely modern and up-to-date that only this ghastly age could produce. A tiny bit of a man pretending he was the whole.”



Rex wanted to get married in the Church, but only because he thought that it would make it a more classy affair. When he met with the priest, he merely parroted what he thought Fr. Mowbray wanted him to say. Julia knew that Rex's inability to approach the sacrament with sincerity and depth did not bode well for him taking marriage seriously.

Julia knew that how we approach to the sacraments reflects the state of our spirit.

Thanks be to God for all of you who will be celebrating milestone sacraments in this season of Easter: Baptisms, First Communions, Confirmations, Ordinations, and Weddings. One could argue that there is little that a person can do that is more noble or more admirable than to take the solemn vow of a sacrament, before God and the world, and then to make a sustained, whole-hearted effort to be faithful to it.

Congratulations, good people! Your serious “yes” to God will bring you serious joy. May God continue to raise up whole, deep, sincere human beings here at St. Vincent de Paul.
